

CROCHET BABY SHOES

Material:

Hook US size : 7.0mm

Yarns: White, Gray and Purple
(Optional)

Sewing needle

Techniques:

- st (stitch)
- ch (chain)
- sl st (slip stitch)
- sc (single crochet)
- hdc (half-double crochet)
- dc (double crochet)
- hdc inc (two half-double crochets in the same stitch)
- dc dec (double crochet decrease)
- Rd (round), Rds (rounds)
- Join (join with slip stitch to the first stitch of the round)
- Magic Circle



Sole:

- Row 1: Chain 16 st, turn.
- Row 2: Ch 2 st, hdc crochet from 2nd to 15th st. Hdb crochet in the 16th st (last st) for 6 times. Hdb crochet in the other side of the chain to the first st and hdc crochet 5 st in the first st. Sl st, turn.
- Row 3: Ch 2 st, hdc crochet from 2nd st to 15th st. Hdb Inc st every stitch from st 16th to 21th st. Hdb crochet st from 22nd to 34th st. Hdb inc st from 35th to 40th st. Sl st, turn.
- Row 4: Ch 2 st, hdc crochet from 2nd st to 15th st. Hdb inc from 16th st to 27th st. Hdb crochet from 28th st to 40th st. Sl st. Finish off.

Top:

Now you will have 77 st from the sole. To start crochet the top you need to insert yarn to the F.o of the sole (77th st).

- Round 1: Ch 2, Dc into the last st. sl st, Turn
- Round 2: Ch 2, Dc from 1st st to 14th st. Dc dec from st 15th st to 38th st. Dc to the last st. Sl st, turn.
- Round 3: Ch 2, Dc from 1st to 14th st, Dc dec from st 15th to 26th st. Dc from 27th to 40th st. Dc dec from 41st to the last st. Sl st, turn.
- Round 4: Chain 2, Hdc to the last st. Sl st, turn
- Chain 2: Hdb 4 st, turn *repeat 5 times*. Sew it into the shoe.

Flowers:

- Magic circle, chain 2, crochet 12 sc, sl st.
- Chain 2 and do 2 dc in the sc closest to your chain. Ch 2 more and slip stitch in that same sc.
- Slip stitch in the next sc to skip it. Slip stitch in the sc after that, then ch 2, 2 dc, ch 2, ss {repeating what you did for the first petal}.

- Repeat, going all the way around the ring, until you have six petals. Join with a ss to first ch 2.
- Sew your flower into the shoes to make decoration
