

Baby Girl's Cape

Chain 38

Hood



Row 1: Dc in 4th chain from hook (counts as first dc here and throughout). Dc in next 33 chains. 2 dc in last chain on hook. Working on opposite side of chain dc in each chain across. (70 dc)

Row 2-17: Chain 3 turn. Dc in each dc around. (70 dc) Hood complete.



Body

To begin the body, turn the hood and begin working on ends of rows for hood.

Row 1: Work 2 sc in side of each dc along bottom edge of hood. This will be used as the draw string row in step 13. (68 sc)

Row 2: Chain 3 turn. 2 dc in first sc. Work 3 dc in each sc across. (The button hole will go at the end of this row. [See Note for Outer Edge])

Rows 3 – 30: Chain 3 turn. Work 1 dc in each dc across. (You can add or delete rows to adjust length)

Outer Edge

Using a second color from this point forward.

Row 1: Work Sc in each dc across and follow around the edge of entire cape. Along side edges, work 2 sc in each dc. Along front edge of hood, work 1 sc in each dc.

Row 2: Work 1 sc in each sc all the way around, with 2 sc in each of the bottom 2 corners.

NOTE: At the end of row 2 of the body work sc, chain 3, skip 2 sc, sc in next sc and around..

Row 3: Sc in each sc around, Work 2 sc in each of the bottom 2 corners and 2 sc in button hole.



Bottom Frill Edge

Row 1: Attach yarn to bottom corner. Chain 3 * skip 2 sc, 5 dc in next dc (to create shell), skip 2 sc, 1 dc in next dc* repeat from * to * across. Turn.

Rows 2-6: Chain 3 (counts as first dc) * 5 dc in center dc of shell, dc in next dc * repeat from * to * across, turn and repeat. (you can add or delete rows to adjust length)

Row 7: Chain 3 (counts as first dc) *chain 3, sc in center dc of shell, chain 3, dc in next dc * repeat from * to * across. Finish Off.



Draw string

Weave yarn through draw string row. Chain 178, 2 dc in 4th chain from hook, 3 dc in next 24 chain links. Sc in next 125 chain links. Keep hook in and weave hook back through draw string row, continuing where you left off 3 dc in each of the remaining 25 chain links. Draw string complete - finish off.

Button

Line up neck line and sew on button on opposite side of button hole.
