

# Serenity

## MATERIALS:

**Yarn:** Lion Brand Cotton Ease, [50% cotton, 50% acrylic; 207 yds/188m per 100 g. ball]  
Color: Terracotta; 6 balls (5 balls for smaller blanket)

*This pattern works well with any type or gauge yarn. Just adjust your needle size accordingly, and keep in mind that your finished blanket will vary in size. The pattern was written for worsted weight.*

**Needles:** 1 set of 5 US size 4 [3.75 mm] double-point needles (DPN)  
1 set of 5 US size 7 [4.50 mm] double-point needles (DPN)  
1 US size 7 [4.50 mm] 16-inch circular needle  
1 US size 7 [4.50 mm] 29-inch circular needle  
1 US size 7 [4.50 mm] 36-inch circular needle

**Notions:** Stitch markers  
Cable Needle  
Tapestry Needles  
1 crochet hook



## FINISHED DIMENSIONS:

<b>Large</b>	approx. 42" x 42"
<b>Small</b>	approx. 38" x 38"

**GAUGE:** 19sts/28 rows = 4" stockinette stitch

## PATTERN NOTES:

You could either use the [Emily Ocker's Circular Cast on](#), or the [Twisted German Cast on](#). If using the circular cast on, there is no need to use the smaller-sized needles.

## GLOSSARY:

<b>K</b>	Knit
<b>P</b>	Purl
<b>S</b>	Slip
<b>CO</b>	Cast On
<b>YO</b>	Yarn Over
<b>K1-b</b>	Knit through back loop
<b>Kfb</b>	Knit into front and back of stitch
<b>K2tog</b>	Knit 2 together
<b>SSK</b>	Slip Slip Knit
<b>DD</b>	Double Decrease: Slip 2 stitches together as if to knit, K1, pass 2 slipped stitches over.
<b>CB2</b>	Slip first 2 stitches onto cable needle and hold in back, knit the next 2 stitches, then knit the stitches on the cable needle
<b>CB4</b>	Slip first 4 stitches onto cable needle and hold in back, knit next 3, <b>then slip the center stitch (stitch at the very left of the cable needle)</b> from the cable needle back to left-hand needle and knit it; then knit remaining 3 stitches from the cable needle
<b>pm</b>	Place stitch marker
<b>sm</b>	Slip stitch markers from left needle to right needle
<b>CN</b>	Cable Needle
<b>BO</b>	Bind off [cast off]



## INSTRUCTIONS:

- On US Size 4 DPNs, CO 8 sts.
- Divide stitches evenly onto 4 DPNs, taking care not to twist

**Edging Charts – 1 & 2**

(As soon as possible, transfer stitches to circular needle and continue working in the round)



- Round 1 and all odd-numbered (WS) rows, knit all unless otherwise indicated
- \*Work Row 2 of Chart B, then work Row 2 of Chart A; repeat from \* a total of 4 times to complete one round. Work all 52 rows of Chart B in pattern as set
- Knit through Chart C once as in above instructions for Chart B, continuing Chart A in pattern as set.
- Knit through Chart D once as in above instructions for Chart B, continuing Chart A in pattern as set. (For the smaller sized blanket, knit rows 1-8 only then proceed to the edging charts)
- Knit through Edging Chart 1 & 2 once as in above instructions for Chart B, continuing Chart A in pattern as set.
- Knit 1 round.
- B/O all stitches loosely.

## Eyelet Section: (Chart D)

- For smaller sized blanket using written instructions, knit rows 92 through 98. Skip rows 100 through 108 and start knitting again with row 109. (you will have 40 stitches less than noted stitch count for each row)
- If doing the smaller size, shift the last CB2 from row 112 to row 114.






