

Minty Bricks

Minty Bricks is an easy to knit asymmetrical triangular shawl. It uses one complete ball of any fingering weight yarn with a yardage about 400m per 100g .

This shawl has an easy remind-able textured pattern and knitting goes fast.

Dimensions: 150 cm x 26 cm

What you'll need?

- 100g of any fingering (4ply) sockyarn with a yardage about 400m/100g (I used 1 ball Schoppel XL Kleckse in color minty)
- circular needles 80 cm, 2,5 mm

Basic Pattern

RS:

p5, k5 until last stitch, kfb

WS:

kfb first stitch, purl all other stitches



Abbreviations

p	= purl
k	= knit
kfb	= knit in front and back of stitch
RS	= right side
WS	= wrong side
st	= stitch / stitches

Let's start!

Use your preferred cast on method and cast on 6 stitches (I used long tail cast on). Turn your work and purl all stitches.

Row 1 (RS):
p5, kfb
(7 stitches)

Row 2 and all other WS rows:
kfb, purl to end
(8 stitches)

Row 3:
p5, k2, kfb
(9 stitches)

Row 5:
p5, k4, kfb
(11 stitches)

Row 7:
p5, k5, p1, kfb
(13 stitches)

Row 9:
p5, k5, p3, kfb
(15 stitches)

Work another WS row

If you take a look to your first 5 stitches on your left handed needle, you'll recognize a wrong side garter stitch square with 5 garter ridges.

Row 11:

Cast off 4 stitches knitwise, Cast off 1 more stitch purlwise. This stitch will count as the first purl stitch in your pattern repeat. To complete the pattern row, p4, then k5, p4 to last stitch, kfb.



Pay attention to kfb the last stitch on every RS row and kfb the first stitch on every WS row.

Repeat the pattern until you have another wrong side garter stitch square with 5 garter ridges. Cast off next stitches as described.

Continue until your ball of yarn seems to run out of yarn. Cast off all stitches knitwise.

Give your shawl a bath. Block it lightly and let it dry flat. Weave in all ends.

Show everyone your new shawl.
