



SHEARWATER



Designed to use only one skein of sock yarn, Shearwater features short row-shaping, relaxing garter stitch and a very simple and eye-catching lace boarder. The result is a light, crescent-shaped shawl that is perfect for summer. Quick and easy to knit, the hardest part will be deciding which sock yarn to use!

Finished Measurements

After Blocking - 55"/140cm wide x 9.5"/24.5cm deep

Yarn

Skein Top Draw Sock
85% Superwash Merino, 15% Nylon
437 yards / 400 meters in 95g
1 skein
Colourway – Vivid Violet

Needles

3.75mm/US 5 circular needle 32"/80cm or longer

Other

Tapestry needle.

Gauge

18 sts and 38 rows to 4 inches/10 cm in Garter Stitch with 3.75mm/US 5 needles after blocking. Because this is a one-size shawl, don't worry too much about gauge.

Instructions

Set-Up

CO 201 sts
Sl first 2 sts WYIB, k to last 2 sts, W+T
K to last 2 sts W+T (197 sts between wrapped stitches)

Garter Stitch Body With Short Row Shaping

Row 1: k to last 2 sts before wrapped stitch, W+T
Row 2: k to last 2 sts before wrapped stitch, W+T
Repeat above 2 rows 20 times more (113 sts between wrapped stitches)

Row 43: k to last 3 sts before wrapped stitch, W+T
Row 44: k to last 3 sts before wrapped stitch, W+T
Repeat above 2 rows 10 times more (47 sts between wrapped stitches)

Row 65: k to last 4 sts before wrapped stitch, W+T
Row 66: k to last 4 sts before wrapped stitch, W+T
Repeat above 2 rows 4 times more (7 sts between wrapped stitches)

Row 75: k across row knitting wrapped sts as you come to them without picking up the wraps.

Row 76: Repeat above row. (201 sts)

Increase Row

Row 77: *k1, yo, repeat from * k1. (401 sts)

Row 78: k all sts

Lace Edging

Row 1: sl 1, k1, pssso, k3, yo, k1, *yo, k3, sl 1, k2tog, pssso, k3, yo, k1* repeat until 5 sts remain, yo, k3, k2tog.

Row 2: k all sts.

Repeat above two rows until you have approx. 10g of yarn left. K two rows and then BO.

Finishing

Block to size and weave in ends.

Abbreviations

st/s	Stitch/es	ssk	Insert right needle into the next stitch as if to knit, slip the stitch onto the right needle, repeat with the next stitch (2 stitches slipped). Insert left needle into both of these slipped stitches and knit them together.
k	Knit	sl1 k2tog pssso	Slip the next stitch onto right needle as if to knit, knit the next 2 stitches together and then pass the slipped stitch over and off the needle (2 sts decreased)
p	Purl	WYIB	With yarn held to the back of the work
k2tog	Knit two stitches together	yo	Yarn over
W+T	Wrap and Turn. Bring yarn to the front of the knitting, sl next stitch onto right needle (as if to purl), turn work over (right needle is now on the left side), bring the yarn forward and slip the stitch from the left needle to the right. Bring the yarn to the back, stitch is now wrapped and work has been turned, continue to knit.	sl	Slip st purlwise
