

## [ SIMPLE little SOMETHING ] *by Wendy Chapman*



*This hand knit bracelet features an interesting, textured stitch and two buttons. As you knit you will notice this stitch pattern makes it's own button holes. It works up quickly and uses minimal yardage. It is a lovely and unique accessory. Save those scraps and make yourself a Simple Little Something.*

### **:: MATERIALS ::**

Approximately .75 oz of worsted weight yarn.  
US size 8 [5.00 mm] straight needles or 2 double pointed needles of the same size.  
Tapestry needle.  
2 buttons .75in/2cm in diameter.

### **:: GAUGE ::**

Gauge is not critical for this project.

### **:: FINISHED MEASUREMENTS ::**

Approximately 7½in/19cm in length and 2¾/7cm inches wide.

### **:: ABBREVIATIONS ::**

CO: Cast On  
Sts: Stitches  
K: Knit  
P: Purl  
P3TOG: Purl 3 sts together  
YRN: Yarn around needle  
Rep: Repeat  
BO: Bind Off  
Make Knot: P3TOG leaving sts on needle, yarn around needle, then purl the same 3 sts together again.

## [ SIMPLE little SOMETHING ] continued...

### :: PATTERN DIRECTIONS ::

CO 16 sts.

**Rows 1, 3, 5 (RS):** Knit.

**Row 2:** \*Make Knot; rep from \* to last st, p1.

**Row 4:** p2, \*Make Knot; rep from \* to last 2 sts, p2.

**Row 6:** p1, \*Make Knot; rep from \* to end.

Work these 6 rows [5] more times and then work Row 1 one more time.

BO and weave in ends. Block to approximate measurements and sew on 2 buttons to CO edge.

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
