## Crochet Basket Candy

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## > INSTRUMENTS AND <br> MATERIALS

- 7 mm crochet hook (or suitable for your yarn size)
- Macrame polyester cord/cotton cord 5 mm (e.g. Bobbiny), $90 \mathrm{~m} / 99$ $y d s(200 m-900 \mathrm{~g})$
- Scissors
- Stitch markers
- Satin ribbon (about $75 \mathrm{~cm} / 30 \mathrm{inch}$ )


## ABBREVIATIONS

Chunky polyester cord 5 mm , durable and sturdy

MEASURES: 7" (17 cm) Diameter and 4" (10 cm) Height
> NOTES

1. Use a stitch marker to keep track of your rounds.
2. Check you have the correct number of stitches after each round.
3. Work in joined rounds.

## THE BOTTOM

Round 1: Make a magic ring. Start into magic ring: Ch 3 (counts as dc), $3 \mathrm{dc}, \mathrm{Ch} 3$, ( $4 \mathrm{dc}, \mathrm{Ch} 3$ ) repeat 3 times. Pull yarn tail to close up the hole, sl st into $3^{\text {rd }}$ st of Ch 3 to join [28]


Round 2: Ch 3 (counts as dc), dc in next 3 st, (2 dc into ch sp, Ch 3, 2 dc into same ch sp, dc in next 4 st ) repeat 3 times, 2 dc into ch sp, Ch $3,2 \mathrm{dc}$ into same ch sp, sl st into $3^{\text {rd }}$ st of Ch 3 to join [44]


Round 3: Ch 3 (counts as dc), dc in next 5 st, (2 dc into ch sp, Ch 3, 2 dc into same ch sp , dc in next 8 st ) repeat 3 times, 2 dc into ch $\mathrm{sp}, \mathrm{Ch} 3,2 \mathrm{dc}$ into same ch sp, dc in next 2 st, sl st into $3^{\text {rd }}$ st of of Ch 3 to join [60]


## THE BODY OF THE BASKET

Round 4: BACK LOOPS ONLY. Ch 1, sc in each st around, sl sl into first sc to join [60]


Round 5: Ch 1, sc in the first st, (sc-tbl in next st, sc in next st) repeat 29 times, sc-tbl in next $s t$, $s l$ sl into first sc to join [60]


Rounds 6-10: Repeat Round 5 [60]
Fasten off and hide yarn tail in.


Decorate the basket with satin ribbon ( 1 cm width) as shown in the picture. Use front loops of Round 9. Tie a bow.
