

Summer Tee

Grace Mcewen Knitting Pattern Designs



Pattern Notes: Summer Tee is a sweet and easy tee knit from a cotton mix. It is light and airy and sure to please. Best of all it is super easy, knit in one piece and short flirty sleeves. Grab your favorite yarn and get knitting!!

Materials Needed:

Size 7(4.5mm) Straight needles and circular needles

Yardage - 788, (926, 1081, 1239, 1395, 1576, 1700) of Premier Cotton Fair 52% Cotton, 48% Acrylic 317 yds

Darning needle / Stitch Holder / stitch marker

Gauge - 16 stitches and 22 rows to equal 4 inches

Abbreviations

K - knit

P - Purl

k3tog -Knit three stitches together as one

Sizes: 30 (32, 36, 40, 44, 48, 52)

Cast on 112(136, 152, 168, 184, 200, 216) stitches on size 7 (4.5mm) circular needles.

Work k2, p2 for 60 (68, 76, 84 , 92, 100, 108) stitches then place stitch marker. Work remainder stitches continuing the k2, p2, to end of row, place stitch marker and join. Continue working k2 , P2 for 1.5 inches then begin working Lace Pattern. (once the full repeat of all rows 1 to 15 are done work in even knit until the tee measures the required measurements.

Lace pattern:

R8: k5, k3tog repeat to end of row

R1: p3, k5 repeat to end of row

R9: knit

R2: p3, k5 repeat to end of row

R10: knit

R3: k3tog, k5 repeat to end of row

R11: p3, k5

R4: knit

R12: p3, k5

R5: knit

R13: k3tog, k5

R6: k5, p3 repeat to end of row

R14: knit

R7: k5, p3 repeat to end of row

R15: knit

Work even knit in the round until the garment measures 16 (16.5, 17, 18.5, 18.5, 18.5, 18.5) inches from cast on. Then bind off for the armholes. Work 58 (66, 73, 81, 89, 96, 104) stitches following lace pattern. Bind off the next 4 (4, 6, 6, 6, 8, 8) stitches and then work even knit until 2, (2, 3, 3, 3, 4, 4) stitches before side stitch marker and then bind off 4,(4, 6, 6, 6, 8, 8) stitches. These bound off sections will be where you join the sleeves. Work remaining row.

Cast on size 7 (4.5mm) straight needles 48(52, 61, 66, 72, 78, 84) stitches for sleeve and work in ribbing for 2 inches. Bind off 3 stitches at the beginning and end of the next row and join. Then join with main body where the bound off stitches are on the body. Work even knit for 2 inches and then work following lace pattern.

Lace Pattern 2;

R6: knit

R1: p3, k5 repeat to end of row

R7: knit

R2: p3, k5 repeat to end of row

R8: k5, p3 repeat to end of row

R3: k3tog, k5 repeat to end of row

R9: k5, p3 repeat to end of row

R4: knit

R10: k5, k3tog repeat to end of row

R5: knit

Then continue working in even knit until the total measures 4(4.5, 4.5, 5, 5.5, 5.5, 5.5) inches from the join.

Begin first decrease - work as follows *k2 k2tog* repeat from * to * to the end of the row

Work even knit until total measures 1.5(1.5, 1.5, 2, 2, 2, 2) from decrease row then begin second decrease *k1 k2tog* repeat from * to * across row and then work an additional 1.5(1.5, 1.5, 2, 2, 2, 2) inches from this decrease and begin neck decrease - *k1, k2tog, k2tog* repeat from * to * across row. Work 1 inch and then 4 rows in k2, p2 ribbing.

Bind off

Weave all ends, sew up sleeves and enjoy!!
