

# Colorful Flower Coasters

These sturdy cotton coasters add colorful panache to any surface. The pattern is super simple and great for beginners – only 3 rounds per coaster! Four or five of them would make a great housewarming gift, stacked and tied with a ribbon, or they could be sewn into a larger mat.

## **Materials:**

US F (3.75mm) crochet hook  
Lily Sugar 'n Cream (100% cotton) in various colors (A and B)  
Yarn needle



## **Abbreviations:**

Chain (Ch), Slip stitch (Sl st),  
Single crochet (Sc), Double crochet (Dc)

## **Coasters:**

With A, ch 6, join with sl st in first ch to form ring.

**Rnd 1:** Ch 4, (dc, ch 1) 11 times in ring, join with sl st in 3<sup>rd</sup> ch of beg ch 4. (12 dc) Fasten off A.

**Rnd 2:** Join B with sc in same st as last sl st, \*ch 3, sc in next dc, repeat from \* around, join with sl st in first sc. (12 ch-3 spaces)

**Rnd 3:** Sl st into ch-3 sp, ch 3 (counts as first dc), 5 dc in same sp, \*ch 1, sc in next ch-3 sp, ch 1, 6 dc in next ch-3 sp, repeat from \* around, ending ch 1, sc in ch-3 sp, ch 1, sl st in 3<sup>rd</sup> ch of beg ch 3. (6 dc groups)

Fasten off.

Weave in all ends.

Alternate colors, using one color for Rnd 1 and a second color for Rnds 2-3.
