

CONCERT

Madeline Tosh Prairie : 840 yards, 768 meters per skein , approximately 600 yards, 550 meters used

US needles 7

190 cm X 95 cm



One knits this shawl in one piece, top down. So, it requires knitting only few stitches at the beginning.

Cast on 5 stitches and knit 1 row.

CHART A

Continue with Chart A Right, 1 central stitch, Chart A Left.

Repeat rows 35 to 58 until row 154. At rows 59, 83, 107, 131 you have to knit 1 pattern (24 stitches) more. (in green).

Purl even rows, except for the edge stitches in blue.

CHART B

At row 155 continue with chart B Right, 1 central stitch, chart B Left.

Be careful, only odd rows are charted. Purl even rows, except for the edge stitches in blue.

Yarn over bind off :

K1,* YO, K1. Use left needle to pass YO and first K1 over last K1 on right needle*

2 stitches with 3 stitches

Knit the first 2 stitches together, keep the central stitch on the needle. Slip the central stitch, knit the 3rd stitch and pass the slipped stitch over.




In blue, edge stitches :

Slip the 1st one, then knit the 2nd one.

At the end of the row, knit 2 stitches.

Do the same at the even row.

CHART A Right


