

Corylus

Corylus is a pretty iPad Sleeve featuring a gorgeous leaf and cable pattern that mimics the twisting branches and leaves of the Hazelnut tree.

Knit in Knit Picks' "Bare Swish Bulky" on smaller needles to create a dense, springy fabric for optimal shock absorption for those perilous falls to the ground



A large button and knitted button loop (No crochet hook needed!) close up the sleeve to ensure that your notebook won't slide out.



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Gauge

Moss Stitch on Size US #9 needles
15 st & 26 rows = 4" Square

Supplies

(1) Hank of Knit Picks Swish Bulky in "Bare"
Size US #9 (5.5mm) 40" Circulars
for working Magic Loop
(1) 1.25" Button
Stitch Marker
Cable Needle
Tapestry Needle
Scissors

Stitches / Abbreviations

K - Knit
P - Purl
RS - Right Side
WS - Wrong Side
CO - Cast On
YO - Yarn Over
K2tog - Knit 2 together
SSK - Slip, Slip, Knit
BO - Bind Off
PSO - Pass stitch over
3-stitch RC - 3 stitch Right-Crossing Cable
[] - Repeat what is shown inbetween set of brackets

Explanation of Stitches & Methods

Judy's Magic Cast-On:

(Used for casting on in the round at the bottom of the work, making the sleeve seamless.)

3-stitch RC - 3 stitch Right-Crossing Cable:

Slip 2 stitches to a Cable Needle, hold to back,
K1 from Left needle, K2 from Cable Needle.

SSK - Slip, slip, knit:

Slip a stitch knitwise, place back onto needle purlwise,
knit 2 stitches together through back loop.

K2tog - Knit 2 together:

Knit 2 stitches together.

Pattern

Using Judy's Magic Cast On, **CO 48** with 32" circs.

Round 1: P1, [K1, P1]twice, K3, [P1, K1]to end of round.

Round 2: K1, [P1, K1]twice, 3RC, K1, [P1, K1]4 times, 3RC, [K1, P1]to end of round.

Round 3: Repeat round 1.

Round 4: [K1, P1]twice, K2tog, YO, K1, YO, SSK, P1, [K1, P1]3 times, K2tog, YO, K1, YO, SSK, P1, [K1, P1]to end of round.

Round 5: P1, K1, P1, K7, P1, [K1, P1]twice, K7, [P1, K1]to end of round.

Round 6: K1, P1, K1, K2tog, YO, K3, YO, SSK, K1, [P1, K1]twice, K2tog, YO, K3, YO, SSK, [K1, P1]to end of round.

Round 7: Repeat round 5.

Round 8: K1, P1, K2tog, YO, K5, YO, SSK, P1, K1, P1, K2tog, YO, K5, YO, SSK, P1, [K1, P1] to end of round.

Round 9: [P1, K1]twice, [P1, K1]to end of round.

Round 10: [K1, K2tog, YO, K7, YO, SSK]twice, [K1, P1]to end.

Round 11: Repeat round 9.

Round 12: [K1, SSK, K3, YO, K1, YO, K3, K2tog]twice, [K1, P1]to end of round.

Round 13: Repeat round 9.

Round 14: Repeat round 12.

Round 15: Repeat round 9.

Round 16: Repeat round 12.

Round 17: Repeat round 9.

Round 18: [K1, YO, SSK, K7, K2tog, YO]twice, [K1, P1]to end of round.

Round 19: Repeat round 9.

Round 20: [K1, P1, YO, SSK, K5, K2tog, YO, P1]twice, [K1, P1]to end of round.

Round 21: Repeat round 5.

Round 22: [K1, P1, K1, YO, SSK, K3, K2tog, YO, K1, P1]twice, [K1,P1]to end of round.

Round 23: Repeat round 5.

Round 24: [K1, P1, K1, P1, YO, SSK, K1, K2tog, YO, P1, K1, P1]twice, [K1, P1]to end.

Round 25: Repeat round 1.

Round 26: Repeat round 2.

Round 27: Repeat round 1.

Round 28: [K1, P1, K1, P1, K5, P1, K1, P1]twice, [K1, P1]to end of round.

Round 29: Repeat round 1.

Round 30: Repeat round 2.

Round 31: Repeat round 1.

Round 32: Repeat round 28.

Round 33: Repeat round 1.

Round 34: Repeat round 2.

Round 35: Repeat round 1.

Pattern (continued)

Round 36: Repeat round 28.

Rounds 37-62: Repeat rounds 1-26.

(Ribbing) Round 63-68: K2, P3, [K3, P3], to 1 stitch from end, K1.

(Bind Off) Round 69: K2, P3, [K3, P3]5 times, to 1 stitch from end, K1, BO all stitches left in round, remove stitch marker.

(Bind Off & Button Loop) Round 70: BO all remaining stitches, you will have 1 BO loop left on your needle, insert right needle through the very first bound off stitch of previous round, YO and pull up a loop, PSO, [YO needle from back to front, PSO]9 times (creating a chain), insert right needle into the same exact stitch as before (first BO stitch), YO and pull up a loop, PSO. (Button loop is now secured.) Break yarn and pull tail through last stitch made.

Finishing: Weave in all ends. Sew on Button, using the button loop as a guide.





Read all rows on chart from right to left.

Note: BO is performed in the middle of the back of the cover for the placement of the button loop.
