



Drop Stitch Cowl

Materials 6oz super bulky yarn or approx. 110 yards such as Lion Brand Thick and Quick

Size 15 20" circular needles

Stitch Marker

Tapestry Needle

The Pattern

Cast on 47 stitches and join for working in the round by slipping the last stitch on your right needle to the left and knitting the first two stitches together (46 stitches). Place a stitch marker to mark the beginning of the round.

Set up Round: Purl

Round 1: Knit

Round 2: Purl

Round 3: Knit

Round 4: Purl

Round 5: *Knit 1, YO twice* repeat ** all the way around to your marker, YO **ONCE**

Round 6: Purl around dropping the YO's without working them

Repeat Rounds 1-6 4 more times

Knit rounds 1-4 (if you're running out of yarn just knit rounds 1-2 or 3 and then

Bind off loosely. Weave in ends. Wear and Enjoy!
