Folded Ivy Button Cowl

Pattern Notes & Stitch Abbreviations

Notes:

This cowl is worked flat in one piece.

This pattern is written in US crochet Terms

The CH 3 at the beginning of a row does not count as a stitch.

Of your 4 buttons, only 3 need to match as the 4th is a hidden button to secure the top of your cowl. Stitches and Abbreviations:

CH- Chain

SC- Single Crochet

DC- Double Crochet

Special Stitch (Cluster): 2 DC, CH 2, SC in same stitch

Materials & Gauge

Materials:

Yarn Bee Soft and Sleek- 1 Skein
7 mm hook
4 buttons- 3 matching, 1 that is closer to
yarn color. ¾-1 inch in diameter
Yarn Needle
Sewing Needle
Thread to match yarn
Scissors

Gauge:

Gauge is not heavily important for this pattern, but as a guide:

After 4 rows of the pattern, the cowl should be around 2.5 inches long and 10-12 inches wide.

Pattern

Chain 30 +4

Row 1: 2 DC, 2 CH, & 1 SC in 4th CH from hook, * Skip 2 stitches, 2 DC, 2 CH, & 1 SC in same stitch* repeat from * to * across. (10 clusters)

Row 2: CH 3, turn. *2 DC, 2 CH, & 1 SC in the CH 2 space of the previous row* repeat from * to * across. (10 clusters)

Rows 3-42: Repeat row 2. (10 clusters)

3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, 17, 18, 19, 20, 21, 22, 23, 24, 25, 26, 27, 28, 29, 30, 31, 32, 33, 34, 35, 36, 37, 38, 39, 40, 41, 42

Once finished with row 42, tie off and weave in ends.

Finishing

Lay cowl flat with starting chain (the flat edge) at the top. Using your sewing needle and thread that matches sew your buttons that are to be seen at rows 3, 6, and 9. Sew last button at row 13.

Finished measurements should be about 10-12 inches wide and 30-32 inches long depending on your tension.

Fold down opposite side of buttons



Fold to match corner without buttons on top of the corner with buttons to make a diamond.



Feed buttons through holes made from the pattern
