Materials

- 1 skein Araucania's *Limari Multicolor* in #556 (61 yds/56m - 100g)
- US 13 needles, circulars or straight needles
- Three 1" buttons
- Tapestry needle

Gauge

- Not important

Stitch Patterns

- Brioche rib

Skill Level



One size fits most

Abbreviations

CO/BO = cast on/bind off

k2tog = knit 2 together

yo = yarn over

Gauge not really important.

CO 14 sts. Work brioche rib for approx 20", or a bit longer if you want a looser fit. Brioche rib is accomplished by knitting the first row, then on the next and every following row, *k1, k1 into the row below, repeat from *, ending with k2. Every row is worked the same.

Next row: knit

Next row: k3, yo, k2tog, k2, yo, k2tog, k2, yo, k2tog, k2.

Knit 2 rows

BO in garter st.

Weave in ends, and wrap around your neck, marking for where you want the buttons.
