Head:

Using Yosemite

(Note: When working in rnds. After joining a rnd., in the next rnd. your first stitch starts in joining stitch. This principle applies to the whole pattern.)

Rnd. 1: ch5, sc in 2nd ch from hook and next 2 ch, 3sc in next ch, (working in opposite side of ch5) sc in next 3 ch, 3sc in last ch, join w/sl st in 1st sc, ch1 (12)

Rnd. 2: (sc in 1st 4 sc, 2sc in next 2 sc)2x, join w/sl st, ch1 (16)

Rnd. 3: (sc in 1st 5 sc, 2sc in next 3 sc)2x, join w/sl st, ch1 (22)

Rnd. 4: sc in 1st 7 sc, 2sc in next 3 sc, sc in next 8 sc, 2sc in next 3 sc, sc in last sc, join w/sl st, ch1 (28)

Rnd. 5: sc in 1st 7 sc, (2sc in next sc, sc in next sc)3x, sc in next 8 sc, (2sc in next sc, sc in next sc)3x, sc in last sc, join w/sl st, ch1 (34)

Rnd. 6: sc in 1st 7 sc, (2sc in next sc, sc in next 2 sc)3x, sc in next 8 sc, (2sc in next sc, sc in next 2 sc)3x, sc in last sc, join w/sl st, ch1 (40)

Rnd. 7: sc in 1st 10 sc, (2sc in next sc, sc in next sc)3x, sc in next 14 sc, (2sc in next sc, sc in next sc)3x, sc in last 4 sc, join w/sl st, ch1 (46)

Rnd. 8: sc in 1st 10 sc, (2sc in next sc, sc in next 2 sc)3x, sc in next 14 sc, (2sc in next sc, sc in next 2 sc)3x, sc in last 4 sc, join w/sl st, ch1 (52)

Rnd. 9: sc in 1st 10 sc, (2sc in next sc, sc in next 3 sc)3x, sc in next 14 sc, (2sc in next sc, sc in next 3 sc)3x, sc in last 4 sc, join w/sl st, ch1 (58)

Rnd. 10: sc in 1st 10 sc, (2sc in next sc, sc in next 4 sc)3x, sc in next 14 sc, (2sc in next sc, sc in next 4 sc)3x, sc in last 4 sc, join w/sl st, ch1 (64)

Rnds. 11-18: (sc in each sc), around, join w/sl st, ch1 (64)

Rnd. 19: sc in 1st 15 sc, sc dec next 2 sc tog, sc in next 6 sc, sc dec next 2 sc tog, sc in next 20 sc, sc dec next 2 sc tog, sc in next 6 sc, sc dec next 2 sc tog, sc in last 9 sc, join w/sl st, ch1 (60)

Rnd. 20: sc in 1st 15 sc, (sc dec next 2 sc tog, sc in next 2 sc)2x, sc dec next 2 sc tog, sc in next 19 sc, (sc dec next 2 sc tog, sc in next 2 sc)2x, sc dec next 2 sc tog, sc in last 6 sc, join w/sl st, ch1 (54)

Rnd. 21: sc in 1st 12 sc, (sc dec next 2 sc tog, sc in next 3 sc)2x, sc dec next 2 sc tog, sc in next 16 sc, (sc dec next 2 sc tog, sc in next 3 sc)2x, sc dec next 2 sc tog, sc in last 2 sc, join w/sl st, ch1 (48)

Rnd. 22: (sc dec 1st 2 sc tog, sc in next 6 sc), around, join w/sl st, ch1 (42)

Rnd. 23: (sc dec 1st 2 sc tog, sc in next 5 sc), around, join w/sl st, ch1 (36)

Rnd. 24: (sc dec 1st 2 sc tog, sc in next 4 sc), around, join w/sl st, ch1 (30)

begin stuffing and shaping head

Rnd. 25: (sc dec 1st 2 sc tog, sc in next 3 sc), around, join w/sl st, ch1 (24)

Rnd. 26: (sc dec 1st 2 sc tog, sc in next 2 sc), around, join w/sl st, ch1 (18)

continue stuffing

Rnd. 27: (sc dec 1st 2 sc tog, sc in next sc), around, join w/sl st, ch1 (12) finish stuffing

Rnd. 28: (sc dec 1st 2 sc tog), around, join w/sl st, F/O (6) leave 4" to cinch end closed. To cinch, weave remaining yarn through remaining sc, pull tight, fasten down, and hide remaining yarn.



Eye Patch: (Make 2)

(One in White Frost, One in Yosemite)

Rnd. 1: 6sc in magic ring, join w/sl st, ch1 (6)

Rnd. 2: (2sc in each sc), around, join w/sl st, ch1 (12)

Rnd. 3: (2sc in 1st sc, sc in next sc), around, join w/sl st, ch1 (18)

Rnd. 4: (3sc in 1st sc, sc in next 2 sc), around, join w/sl st, ch1 (30)

Rnd. 5: sc in 1st sc, (2sc in next sc, sc in next 4 sc)5x, 2sc in next sc, sc in last 3 sc, join w/sl st, ch1 (36)

Rnd. 6: sc in 1st sc, (2sc in next sc, sc in next 5 sc)5x, 2sc in next sc, sc in last 4 sc, join w/sl st, F/O (42) leave 12" to sew eye patch to head. First add the eye inserting the back of the eye through the middle of rnd. 1 and add the back of the eye piece. Make both eyes before continuing. Once both eyes are complete pin the eyes to the head between rnds. 6 & 19 on the head. **NOTE: I HIGHLY suggest pinning these pieces and every other piece on before sewing to ensure you're happy with the placement.** Refer to picture:



Head Patch:

Using White Frost

(Note: When working in rows. DO NOT CH1, it give a straighter edge without the ch1. This principle applies to whole pattern.)

Row 1: ch11, 2sc in 2nd ch from hook, sc in next 8 ch, 2sc in last ch, turn (12)

Row 2: 2sc in 1st sc, sc in next 10 sc, 2sc in last sc, turn (14)

Rows 3-12: (sc in each sc), across, turn (14)

Rnd. 13: sc dec 1st 2 sc tog, sc in next 10 sc, sc dec 2 sc tog, turn (12)

Rnd. 14: sc dec 1st 2 sc tog, sc in next 8 sc, sc dec 2 sc tog, turn (10)

Rnd. 15: sc dec 1st 2 sc tog, sc in next 6 sc, sc dec 2 sc tog, turn (8)

Rnd. 16: sc dec 1st 2 sc tog, sc in next 4 sc, sc dec 2 sc tog, turn (6)

Rnd. 17: sc dec 1st 2 sc tog, sc in next 2 sc, sc dec 2 sc tog, turn (4)

Rnd. 18: (sc dec 1st 2 sc tog)2x, turn (2)

Rnd. 19: sc dec 1st 2 sc tog, F/O (1) leave 18" to sew head patch to head. Sew head patch between rnds. 1 & 19 on head. Refer to picture...





Body:

Using White Frost

Rnd. 1: 8sc in magic ring, join w/sl st, ch1 (8)

Rnd. 2: (2sc in each sc), around, join w/sl st, ch1 (16)

Rnd. 3: (2sc in 1st sc, sc in next sc), around, join w/sl st, ch1 (24)

Rnd. 4: (2sc in 1st sc, sc in next 3 sc), around, join w/sl st, ch1 (30)

Rnd. 5: (2sc in 1st sc, sc in next 4 sc), around, join w/sl st, ch1 (36)

Rnd. 6: (2sc in 1st sc, sc in next 5 sc), around, join w/sl st, ch1 (42)

Rnd. 7: (2sc in 1st sc, sc in next 6 sc), around, join w/sl st, ch1 (48)

Rnd. 8: (2sc in 1st sc, sc in next 7 sc), around, join w/sl st, ch1 (54)

Rnd. 9: (2sc in 1st sc, sc in next 8 sc), around, join w/sl st, ch1 (60)

Rnds. 10-13: (sc in each sc), around, join w/sl st, ch1 (60)

Rnd. 14: (sc dec 1st 2 sc tog, sc in next 8 sc), around, join w/sl st, ch1 (54)

Rnd. 15: (sc dec 1st 2 sc tog, sc in next 7 sc), around, join w/sl st, ch1 (48)

Rnd. 16: (sc in each sc), around, join w/sl st, ch1 (48)

Rnd. 17: (sc dec 1st 2 sc tog, sc in next 6 sc), around, join w/sl st, ch1 (42)


Rnd. 18: (sc dec 1st 2 sc tog, sc in next 5 sc), around, join w/sl st, ch1 (36)

Rnds. 19-21: (sc in each sc), around, join w/sl st, ch1 (36)

Rnd. 22: (sc dec 1st 2 sc tog, sc in next 4 sc), around, join w/sl st, ch1 (30)

Rnd. 23: (sc dec 1st 2 sc tog, sc in next 3 sc), around, join w/sl st, ch1 (24)

Rnd. 24: (sc dec 1st 2 sc tog, sc in next 2 sc), around, join w/sl st, F/O (18) leave 12" to sew body to head. Stuff body, then sew body to bottom of head.





Body Patch:

Using Yosemite

Row 1: ch6, sc in 2nd ch from hook and next 3 ch, 2sc in last ch, turn (6)

Row 2: 2sc in 1st sc, sc in last 5 sc, turn (7)

Row 3: sc in 1st 6 sc, 2sc in last sc, turn (8)

Row 4: 2sc in 1st sc, sc in next 7 sc, turn (9)

Row 5: sc in 1st 9 sc, ch3, turn (9)

Row 6: sc in 2nd ch from hook and next ch, sc in last 9 sc, turn (11)

Row 7: sc in 1st 11 sc, ch2, turn (11)

Row 8: sc in 2nd ch from hook, sc in last 11 sc, turn (12)

Row 9: sc in 1st 12 sc, ch3, turn (12)

Row 10: sc in 2nd ch from hook and next ch, sc in last 12 sc, turn (14)

Row 11: sc in 1st 13 sc, 2sc in last ch, turn (15)

Row 12: sc dec 1st 2 sc tog, sc in last 13 sc, turn (14)

Row 13: sc in 1st 12 sc, sc dec last 2 sc tog, turn (13)

Row 14: sc dec 1st 2 sc tog, sc in last 11 sc, turn (12)

Row 15: sc in 1st 10 sc, sc dec last 2 sc tog, turn (11)

Row 16: sc dec 1st 2 sc tog, sc in last 9 sc, turn (10)

Rows 17-22: (sc in each sc), around, join w/sl st, ch1 (10)

Row 23: sc in 1st 9 sc, 2sc in last sc, turn (11)

Row 24: 2sc in 1st sc, sc in last 10 sc, turn (12)

Row 25: sc in 1st 11 sc, 2sc in last sc, turn (13)

Row 26: 2sc in 1st sc, sc in last 12 sc, turn (14)

Row 27: sc in 1st 13 sc, 2sc in last sc, turn (15)

Row 28: sc dec 1st 2 sc tog, sc in last 13 sc, turn (14)

Row 29: sc in 1st 12 sc, sc dec last 2 sc tog, turn (13)

Row 30: sc dec 1st 2 sc tog, sc in last 11 sc, turn (12)

Row 31: sc in 1st 10 sc, sc dec last 2 sc tog, turn (11)

Row 32: sc dec 1st 2 sc tog, sc in last 9 sc, turn (10)

Rows 33-38: (sc in each sc), across, turn (10)

Row 39: sc in 1st 9 sc, 2sc in last sc, turn (11)

Row 40: 2sc in 1st sc, sc in last 10 sc, turn (12)

Row 41: sc in 1st 11 sc, 2sc in last sc, turn (13)

Row 42: 2sc in 1st sc, sc in last 12 sc, turn (14)


Row 43: sc in 1st 13 sc, 2sc in last sc, turn (15)

Row 44: sc dec 1st 2 sc tog, sc in last 13 sc, turn (14)

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Row 45: sc in 1st 12 sc, sl st in next sc, turn (13)
 Row 46: sk 1st sl st, sc in last 12 sc, turn (12)
 Row 47: sc in 1st 11 sc, sl st in next sc, turn (12)
 Row 48: sk 1st sl st, sc in last 11 sc, turn (11)
 Row 49: sc in 1st 9 sc, sl st in next sc, turn (10)
 Row 50: sk 1st sl st, sc in last 9 sc, turn (9)
 Row 51: sc in 1st 7 sc, sl st in next sc, turn (8)
 Row 52: sk 1st sl st, sc dec next 2 sc tog, sc in last 5 sc, turn (6)
 Row 53: sc in 1st 5 sc, sl st in last sc, turn (6)
 Row 54: sk 1st sl st, sc in next 5 sc (5) **DO NOT TURN** (working across top/side)
 Row 55: (sc dec 1st 2 spaces tog, sc in next 7 sc)6x, turn (48)
 Row 56: (sc dec 1st 2 sc tog, sc in next 6 sc)6x, F/O (42) leave a VERY long tail.
 Pin the back bottom point on body, directly under head patch point. Then pin the rest. **NOTE:** The top of the back patch will more than likely be too big; you'll have to squish the top together while you sew it on. Sew the very top of the back patch as close to the head as possible.



Fingers: (Make 6, 3 for each hand)

Starting w/Beige

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1st 2 Fingers:

Rnd. 1: 6sc in magic ring, join w/sl st, ch1 (6)
Rnds. 2-4: (sc in each sc), around, join w/sl st, (6)
F/O 1st 2 fingers. Stuff and take the 1st 2 fingers and tie the ends in a knot. Set these two to the side for now. Do NOT F/O or do NOT ch1 on 3rd Finger.

Switch to Beige before continuing...

3rd Finger Continued:

(NOTE: Pictures are only a little help and are not worked exactly like this pattern.)

You will be connecting the fingers now. Take your time with these steps!

Rnd. 5: Place your 3rd finger next to the two fingers that are tied together. Join w/sl st in 3rd sc from knot on one side of one of the tied together fingers. This will join all three fingers. Ch1, 2sc in same sc as joining, sc in the next sc, 2sc next sc, sk over to the last finger, (sc next sc, 2sc in next sc)3x around this 3rd finger, sk back over to the middle finger, sc in next sc, 2sc in next sc, sc in next sc, sk over to the last finger, (2sc in next sc, sc in next sc)3x around, join w/sl st in very 1st sc, ch1 (27)

Rnds. 6-8: (sc in each sc), around, join w/sl st, ch1 (27)

Rnd. 9: (sc dec 1st 2 sc tog, sc in next 7 sc)3x, join w/sl st, ch1 (24)

Rnd. 10: (sc in each sc), around, join w/sl st, ch1 (24)

Rnd. 11: (sc dec 1st 2 sc tog, sc in next 6 sc)3x, join w/sl st, ch1 (21)

Rnd. 12: (sc in each sc), around, join w/sl st, ch1 (21)

Rnd. 13: (sc dec 1st 2 sc tog, sc in next 5 sc)3x, **join Yosemite w/sl st**, ch1 (18)

Rnd. 14: (sc in each sc), around, join w/sl st, ch1 (18)

Rnd. 15: (sc dec 1st 2 sc tog, sc in next 4 sc)3x, join w/sl st, ch1 (15)

Rnds. 16-17: (sc in each sc), around, join w/sl st, ch1 (15)

Rnd. 18: (sc dec 1st 2 sc tog, sc in next 3 sc)3x, join w/sl st, ch1 (12)

Rnd. 19: sc in 1st 4 sc, sl st in next, F/O (5) leave 8" to sew arm to body. First stuff arm lightly. Then sew arm to body a couple rnds. down from the head.

Refer to picture:





Toes: (Make 2 Large, 2 Medium)

Using Beige

Large Toe:

Rnd. 1: 6sc in magic ring, join w/sl st, ch1 (6)

Rnd. 2: (sc in each sc), join w/sl st, F/O (6) leave 5" to sew toe to foot. Set to side for now...

Medium Toe:

Rnd. 1: 5sc in magic ring, join w/sl st, ch1 (5)

Rnd. 2: (sc in each sc), join w/sl st, F/O (5) leave 5" to sew toe to foot. Set to side for now...



Foot: (Make 2)

Using Beige

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Rnd. 1: 6sc in magic ring, join w/sl st, ch1 (6)
 Rnd. 2: (2sc in each sc), around, join w/sl st, ch1 (12)
 Rnd. 3: (2sc in 1st sc, sc in next sc), around, join w/sl st, ch1 (18)
 Rnd. 4: (2sc in 1st sc, sc in next 2 sc), around, join w/sl st, ch1 (24)
 Rnd. 5: (2sc in 1st sc, sc in next 3 sc), around, join w/sl st, ch1 (30)
 Rnd. 6: sc in 1st 19 sc, puff stitch in next sc, sc in last 10 sc, join w/sl st, ch1 (30)
 Rnd. 7: (sc dec 1st 2 sc tog, sc in next 3 sc), around, join w/sl st, ch1 (24)
 Rnd. 8: (sc dec 1st 2 sc tog, sc in next 2 sc), around, join w/sl st, ch1 (18)
 begin stuffing **LIGHTLY**
 Rnd. 9: (sc dec 1st 2 sc tog, sc in next sc), around, join w/sl st, ch1 (12) finish stuffing
 Rnd. 10: (sc dec 1st 2 sc tog), around, join w/sl st, F/O (6) leave 4" to cinch end closed. To cinch, weave remaining yarn through remaining sc, pull tight, fasten down, and hide remaining yarn. Now begin sewing the toes on. NOTE that the toes go (Puff, M-Medium, L-Large) for the one foot. Sew the toes on one side of the puff stitch for one foot and the other side of the puff stitch for the other foot. Also make note that beginning rnds. are the BOTTOM of the foot. Set the feet to the side for now...



Leg: (Make 2)

Using White Frost

Rnd. 1: beginning with 12", ch30, join w/sl st in 1st ch forming a ring (be sure not to let it twist), ch1, (sc in each ch), around, join w/sl st, ch1 (30)

Rnds. 2-3: (sc in each sc), around, join w/sl st, ch1 (30)

Rnd. 4: (sc dec 1st 2 sc tog, sc in next 8 sc)3x, join w/sl st, ch1 (27)

Rnd. 5: (sc in each sc), around, join w/sl st, ch1 (27)

Rnd. 6: (sc dec 1st 2 sc tog, sc in next 7 sc)3x, join w/sl st, ch1 (24)

Rnd. 7: sc in 1st sc, hdc in next 8 sc, sc in next sc, sl st in next sc, F/O (11)

leave 10" to sew leg to body. First sew rnd. 1 of the leg to the foot. Sew rnd. 1 of the leg at an angle on the foot. Pin rnd. 2 of the leg to the foot, leaving rnd. 1 loose. Here are some things to keep in mind: 1: the last rnd. goes on the outside of the body. 2: The last rnd. should be on the side with the little toes. 3: You need a right and left leg. Stuff leg and sew legs to body between rnds. 2 & 9 on body. Refer to pictures:



Before you continue now is a good time to fluff your Gizmo. Using your nail brush to flush up the fur by brushing it. NOTE: You don't want the beige fluffy, so avoid those areas. Here is a little video I made to help you out:

Muzzle:

Using Beige

Rnd. 1: ch6, sc in 2nd ch from hook and next 3 ch, 3sc in next ch, (working in opposite side of ch6) sc in next 4 ch, 3sc in last ch, join w/sl st in 1st sc, ch1 (14)

Rnd. 2: (sc in 1st 5 sc, 2sc in next 2 sc)2x, join w/sl st, ch1 (18)

Rnd. 3: (sc in 1st 6 sc, 2sc in next sc, 2hdc in next sc, 2sc in next sc)2x, join w/sl st, ch1 (24)

Rnd. 4: sc in 1st 9 sc, 3sc in next sc, sc in next 11 sc, 3sc in next sc, sc in last 2 sc, join w/sl st, F/O (28) leave 12" to sew muzzle to head. Stuff muzzle lightly and sew muzzle to the head. I don't know how to explain the placement so please refer to picture but you will need the 3sc on the side/corners of the muzzle:




Nose:

Using Beige

Rnd. 1: ch3, sc in 2nd ch from hook, 3sc in next ch, (working in opposite side of ch6) sc in next ch, 3sc in last ch, join w/sl st in 1st sc, ch1 (8)

Rnd. 2: (sc in each sc), join w/sl st, F/O (8) leave 5" to sew nose to head. Sew the nose directly above the muzzle on the head. Refer to picture:





Chin Hair:

Using White Frost

Row 1: ch3, 2sc in 2nd ch from hook, sc in last ch, turn (3)

Row 2: 2sc in 1st sc, sc in next sc, 2sc in last sc, turn (5)

Row 3: 2sc in 1st sc, sc in next 3 sc, 2sc in last sc, F/O (7) leave 8" to sew chin hair to bottom of muzzle. Refer to picture for placement ideas.



Eye Lid:

Using Beige

Ch9, sl in 2nd ch from hook, sc in next 6 ch, sl st in last ch, F/O (8) leave 6" to sew eyelid to head. First tie the beginning and ending yarn in a knot. Now sew the eye lid over the top of the plastic eye with the ch side being sew to eye patch.



Ear: (Make 4, 2 for each ear)

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Using Beige

Row 1: ch5, 2sc in 1st sc, sc in next 2 sc, 2sc in last sc, turn (6)

Row 2: 2sc in 1st sc, sc in next 5 sc, ch3, turn (7)

Row 3: 2sc in 2nd ch from hook, sc in next ch, sc in last 7 sc, turn (10)

Row 4: sc in 1st 10 sc, ch3, turn (10)

Row 5: 2sc in 2nd ch from hook, sc in next ch, sc in last 10 sc, turn (13)

Row 6: sc in 1st 4 sc, hdc in next 8 sc, 2hdc in next sc, ch3, turn (14)

Row 7: 2hdc in 1st st, hdc in next 11 sts, sc in next 2 st, sc dec last 2 sts tog, turn (16)

Row 8: sk 1st sc, sc in next 3 sts, hdc next 11 sts, 2hdc in next st, ch3, turn (16)

Row 9: 2hdc in 2nd ch from hook, hdc in next ch, hdc in next 12 sts, sc in next 2 sts, sc dec last 2 sts tog, turn (18)

Row 10: sk 1st sc, sc in next 3 sts, hdc in next 13 sts, 2hdc in last st, turn (18)

Row 11: 2hdc 1st st, hdc in next 15 sts, sc in last 2 sts, turn (19)

Row 12: sk 1st st, sc in next st, hdc in last 17 sts, turn (18)

Row 13: hdc in 1st 17 sts, sc in last st, turn (18)

Row 14: sk 1st st, sc in next st, hdc in next 15 sts, 2hdc in last st, (18) F/O 1st of 2 ear pieces

2nd Ear Continued:

Row/Rnd. 15: place the 2 ear pieces over top of each other, sc through both pieces going around the whole piece with 2sc when you feel the piece needs it and 3sc in the sharp corners (?) hide extra yarn. With a 6" piece sew the side of the 1st few rows to the side of the head between rnds. 9 & 18 on head. Refer to picture:





Ear Hair:

Using Yosemite

Row 1: ch17, sc in 2nd ch from hook and next ch, hdc in next 12 ch, sc in last 2 ch, turn (16)

Row 2: sk 1st sc, sc in next 2 sts, hdc in next 10 sts, sc in next 2 sts, sl st in last st, F/O (15) leave 12" to sew ear hair to head. First take the beginning and ending yarn and tie them in a knot. Fluff the piece up first, then wrap the ear hair around the ear. You need the ch side of the piece on the head. Pin the bottom of the ear hair at the bottom of the ear, go up and OVER the ear and pin to the other side/bottom of the ear. Sew the ear hair in place. Refer to picture:



Finishing:

Using Regular Black yarn

Add the mouth lines and nose spots. I suggest you outline the mouth using straight pins and follow using your yarn with a simple in and out stitch. Refer to picture:
