

# Ice-Cream Bunny Baby

## PDF Amigurumi Pattern

Materials: Worsted weight yarn in 3 colors of your choice, C/2.5 mm crochet hook, 15mm black safety eyes, White felt, Yarn needle, Embroidery needle, stuffing

Stitches used: Magic ring, Chain, Slip stitch, Single crochet, Increase, Invisible decrease, Basic embroidery

Yarn colors I used: A.) Lt. Pink, used for body, ears, legs and stripes on arms. B.) Lt. Orchid, used for feet, ice-cream and stripes. C.) Country Red, used for cherry, eye patches, heart and stripes.

### Abbreviations

Mr. = Magic ring

Ch. = Chain

Sl. = Slip stitch

Sc. = Single crochet

Inc. = Increase

Dec. = Invisible decrease

St(s) = Stitch(es)

Prev. = Previous

## **Body**

With Color A and C/2.5 mm hook

- 1.) Sc 6 into magic ring (6)
- 2.) Inc. in each stitch around (12)
- 3.) \*Sc 1, inc. Repeat from \* 6X (18)
- 4.) \*Sc 2, inc. Repeat from \* 6X (24)
- 5.) \*Sc 3, inc. Repeat from \* 6X (30)
- 6.) \*Sc 4, inc. Repeat from \* 6X (36)
- 7.) Sc in each st around (36)
- 8.) Sc in each st around (36)
- 9.) Sc in each st around (36)
- 10.) Sc in each st around (36)
- 11.) Sc in each st around (36)
- 12.) Sc in each st around (36)
- 13.) Sc in each st around (36)
- 14.) \*Sc 4, dec. Repeat from \* around 6X (30)
- 15.) Sc in each st around (30)
- 16.) Sc in each st around (30)
- 17.) \*Sc 3, dec. Repeat from \* around 6X (24)
- 18.) Sc in each st around (24)
- 19.) Sc in each st around (24)
- 20.) \*Sc 2, dec. Repeat from \* 6X (18)
- 21.) Sc in each st around (18)
- 22.) \* Sc 1, dec. Repeat from \* 6X (12)

Cut your yarn, leaving a 6-8 inch tail. Pull the tail through the last stitch on your hook. Stuff the body firmly with stuffing of your choice.

## **Heart (for belly)**

Using color C and C/2.5 mm hook

- 1.) Ch. 2, 2 sc in the second ch. From hook (2)
- 2.) Ch 1 and turn. Inc. in each st. (4)
- 3.) Ch 1 and turn. Sc in each st. (4)
- 4.) Ch 1 and turn. Inc., Sc 2, Inc. (6)
- 5.) Ch 1 and turn. Inc., Sc 4, Inc. (8)
- 6.) Ch 1 and turn. Sc in each st. (8)
- 7.) Ch 1 and turn. Sc in next 4 sts., leaving 4 sts. unworked. (4)
- 8.) Ch 1 and turn. Sc 1, Dec., Sc 1. (3)
- 9.) Ch 1 and turn. Sc 1, Dec. (2)

Cut the yarn and pull through the last loop on your hook. Repeat rows 7-9 on the 4 stitches that were left unworked. Cut yarn again, leaving a 6 inch tail, and pull through the last loop on your hook.

## **Eye Patches**

Using color C and C/2.5 mm hook

*Make 2*

- 1.) Sc 10 into magic ring (10)
- 2.) Inc. in each st. around (20)

Cut yarn, leaving a 6 inch tail. Pull the tail through the last loop on your hook. Put the safety eyes through the center of each eye patch. DO NOT attach the backs yet. Set these aside for later.

## **Head**

Using color A and C/2.5 mm hook

- 1.) Sc 6 into magic ring (6)
- 2.) Inc. in each st. around (12)
- 3.) \*Sc 1, inc. Repeat from \* 6X (18)
- 4.) \*Sc 2, inc. Repeat from \* 6X (24)
- 5.) \*Sc 3, inc. Repeat from \* 6X (30)
- 6.) \*Sc 4, inc. Repeat from \* 6X (36)
- 7.) \*Sc 5, inc. Repeat from \* 6X (42)
- 8.) Sc in each st. around (42)
- 9.) \*Sc 6, inc. Repeat from \* 6X (48)
- 10.) Sc in each st. around (48)
- 11.) \*Sc 7, inc. Repeat from \* 6X (54)
- 12.) Sc in each st. around (54)
- 13.) Sc in each st. around (54)
- 14.) Sc in each st. around (54)
- 15.) Sc in each st. around (54)
- 16.) Sc in each st. around (54)
- 17.) Sc in each st. around (54)
- 18.) Sc in each st. around (54)
- 19.) Sc in each st. around (54)
- 20.) \*Sc 7, dec. Repeat from \* 6X (48)
- 21.) Sc in each st. around (48)
- 22.) \*Sc 6, dec. Repeat from \* 6X (42)
- 23.) Sc in each st. around (42)
- 24.) \*Sc 5, dec. Repeat from \* 6X (36)
- 25.) \*Sc 4, dec. Repeat from \* 6X (30)
- 26.) \*Sc 3, dec. Repeat from \* 6X (24)

Using my photos as a guide, insert safety eyes between your crochet stitches and secure the backs. Sew the eye patches into place using yarn tails. Stuff the head firmly.

- 27.) \*Sc 2, dec. Repeat from \* 6X (18)
- 28.) \*Sc 1, dec. Repeat from \* 6X (12)

Cut your yarn, leaving a 6-8 inch tail. Pull the tail through the last loop on your hook.

## **Ice-Cream Topping**

Using color B and C/2.5 mm hook

- 1.) Sc 6 in magic ring (6)
- 2.) Inc. in each st. around (12)
- 3.) \*Sc 1, inc. Repeat from \* 6X (18)
- 4.) \*Sc 2, inc. Repeat from \* 6X (24)
- 5.) \*Sc 3, inc. Repeat from \* 6X (30)
- 6.) \*Sc 4, inc. Repeat from \* 6X (36)
- 7.) \*Sc 5, inc. Repeat from \* 6X (42)
- 8.) Sc in each st. around (42)

This part is more of a set of instructions than a “follow these instructions exactly” pattern.

- 1.) Sc in next st. Chain 4-11 stitches. Sc in 2<sup>nd</sup> chain from hook, and every following chain until you get back to your stitches in the round. Vary the amount of chains each time you repeat these

steps to achieve the random dripping effect of an ice-cream topping.

2.) Sc in next st.

3.) Sc in next st.

Repeat these steps until you get to the end of your round. You should end up with 14 drips of varied lengths. Cut your yarn, leaving a 15-16 inch tail, and pull it through the last loop on your hook.

### **Cherry**

Using color C and C/2.5 mm hook

1.) Sc 6 in magic ring (6)

2.) Inc. in each st. around (12)

3.) Sc in each st. around (12)

4.) Sc in each st. around (12)

5.) Sc in each st. around (12)

6.) Dec. around (6)

Cut your yarn, leaving a 4-5 inch tail. Pull the tail through the last loop on your hook. Insert your hook into the top-center on the cherry, where you began with your magic ring. Grab the tail with your hook, and pull it through to the top to act as the stem of the cherry. Snip off any excess yarn.

Using yarn color C and yarn needle, sew the cherry onto the ice-cream topping. Then, using the existing yarn tail, sew the topping onto the head. The unworked stitches of the head should be on the bottom, uncovered by the topping.

### **Ears**

*Make 2*

Using color A and C/2.5 mm hook

1.) Sc 6 in magic ring (6)

2.) Inc. in each st. around (12)

3.) \*Sc 1, inc. Repeat from \* 6X (18)

4.) \*Sc 2, inc. Repeat from \* 6X (24)

Rounds 5-30.) Sc in each st. around (24)

Row 1.) Ch 1 and turn. Pinch the opening of the ear closed and sc through both layers of stitches. (12)

Row 2.) Ch 1 and turn. Pinch the prev. row in half another time, and sc through both layers of sts. (6)

Cut your yarn, leaving a 6-8 inch tail. Pull the tail through the last loop on your hook.

### **Legs**

*Make 2*

Using color B and C/2.5 mm hook

1.) Sc 6 in magic ring (6)

2.) Inc. in each st. around (12)

3.) \*Sc 1, inc. Repeat from \* 6X (18)

4.) Sc 6, inc, sc 3, inc, sc 7 (20)

5.) Sc 7, inc, sc 3, inc, sc 8 (22)

6.) Sc in each st. around (22)

Switch to color A

7.) Sc 7, dec, sc 3, dec, sc 8 (20)

8.) Sc 6, dec, sc 3, dec, sc 7 (18)

9.) Sc 5, dec, sc 3, dec, sc 6 (16)

10.) Sc 4, dec, sc 3, dec, sc 5 (14)

Rounds 11-23.) Sc in each st. around (14) Stuff firmly, using a thick marker or wooden dowel to get the stuffing down into the feet.

24.) Dec. around (7)

Cut your yarn, leaving a 6 inch tail. Pull your tail through the last loop on your hook.

### Arms

*Make 2*

Using yarn color A and C/2.5 mm hook

1.) Sc 6 in magic ring (6)

2.) Inc. in each st. around (12)

3.) Sc in each st. around (12)

Switch to color B

4.) Sc in each st. around (12)

5.) Sc 5, double crochet 3 into next st., remove hook from the last st. and put it in the top of the first dc you made. Grab the loop you removed your hook from, and pull in through., Sc in next 6 stitches. (12)

6.) Sc in each st. around (12)

Switch to color A

7.) Sc in each st. around (12)

8.) Sc in each st. around (12)

9.) Sc in each st. around (12)

Switch to color C

10.) Sc in each st. around (12)

11.) Sc in each st. around (12)

12.) Sc in each st. around (12)

Switch to color A

13.) Sc in each st. around (12)

14.) Sc in each st. around (12)

15.) Sc in each st. around (12)

Switch to color B

16.) Sc in each st. around (12)

17.) Sc 6, sl 6 (12)

18.) Sc in each st. around (12)

Switch to color A

19.) Sc in each st. around (12)

20.) Sc in each st. around (12)

21.) Sc in each st. around (12)

Switch to color C

22.) Sc in each st. around (12)

23.) Sc in each st. around (12)

24.) Sc in each st. around (12)

Switch to color A

25.) Sc in each st. around (12)

26.) Sc in each st. around (12) Stuff the arm firmly, using a thick marker or wooden dowel to get the stuffing down into the hands.

27.) Dec. around (6)

Cut your yarn, leaving a 6 inch tail. Pull the tail through the last loop on your hook.

Using existing yarn tails, sew the head and body together where they were both left open.

Find a good placement for the legs and arms, also using my photos as a guide. Sew them into place using the yarn tails.

Now find a good placement for both ears and sew them into place using the tails.

Cut a small circle from a sheet of white craft felt. Using embroidery floss, embroider a small, triangular nose and upside-down "V" shaped mouth. Sew or glue into place between the eyes.
