

# Lacey Baby Cardigan

Size 0-3 months  
Design by Karena Conran



This pattern is for the cardigan pictured. The pattern for the hat and booties are available separately in my ravelry store.

## Materials :

100g of double knit yarn  
A pair of 3.25mm and 4mm straight needles.

## Suggested yarns:

The pictured set is made in King Cole splash dk but any dk yarn will work well.

## Tension:

22st and 32 rows to 10cm (4 inches) square over lace pattern on 4mm needles.

## Abbreviations:

K : knit  
P: purl  
St: stitch  
K2tog: knit 2 stitches together  
P2tog: purl 2 stitches together  
Yf: bring the yarn forward between needles  
Sl 1 : slip 1 stitch knitwise  
Pssso : pass the slipped stitch over the stitch you just knitted  
Patt. ; pattern

## Instructions:

### Back:

Using 3.25mm needles cast on 57 stitches

#### **1x1 Rib:**

Row 1: \*k1, p1, repeat to last stitch, k1

Row 2: \*p1, k1 repeat to last stitch, p1

Work 7 more rows in 1x1 rib

Next row : rib 5, rib 2tog, \*rib 3, rib 2tog

repeat from \* to last 5 stitches, rib 5

(47 stitches on needle)

Change to 4mm needles

### Lace pattern

Row 1: knit

Row 2: purl

Row 3: K1, \*k1, yf, k2tog repeat from \* to last stitch, K1

Row 4: K1, \*k1, yf, k2tog, repeat from \* to last stitch, K1

Repeat rows 1-4 of lace pattern until work measures 15cm ending with row 4.

### Shape raglan

Cast off 3 stitches a beginning of next 2 rows (41 st)

Keeping lace pattern correct you will be decreasing 1 st at each end of next and every alternate row as follows

**Row 1:** k1, sl1, k1, pssso, pattern to last 3 stitches, k2tog, k1

**Row 2:** P2, pattern to last 2 stitches, P2

Repeat rows 1 & 2 until 15 stitches remain on needle, ending with row 2. Cast off remaining 15 stitches.

### **Left Front**

Using 3.25mm needles cast on 28 stitches

#### **1x1 rib**

Row 1: \* K1, P1, repeat from \* to end

Row 2: \*k1, P1, repeat from \* to end

Work 7 more rows in 1x1 rib

Next row: rib 3, \* rib 2tog, rib 3, repeat from \* to end (23 stitches)

Change to 4mm needles

#### ***Lace pattern***

Row 1: knit

Row 2: purl

Row 3: K1, \*k1, yf, k2tog repeat from \* to last stitch, K1

Row 4: K1, \*k1, yf, k2tog, repeat from \* to last stitch, K1

Repeat rows 1-4 of lace pattern until work measures 15 cm ending with a wrong side row

#### **Shape raglan**

Cast off 3 stitches, pattern to end of row (20 st)

Next row: pattern

Keeping lace pattern correct you will be decreasing 1 st at raglan edge of next and every alternate row as follows

**Row 1:** k1, sl1, k1, pss0, pattern to end of row (19 st)

**Row 2:** pattern to last 2 stitches, P2

Repeat rows 1 & 2 until 10 stitches remain on needle, ending with a right side row.

#### ***Shape neck***

Cast off 3 stitches, pattern to last 2 st, p2 (7 st)

Row 1: k1, sl1, k1, pss0, pattern to last 2 st, k2tog (5 st)

Row 2: p2tog, patt to last 2 st, p2 (4 st)

Row 3: k1, sl1, k1, pss0, pattern to end (3 st)

Row 4: pattern

Row 5: k1, sl1, k1, pss0 (2st)

Row 6: purl 2tog

Fasten off

### **Right Front**

Using 3.25mm needles cast on 28 stitches

#### **1x1 rib**

Row 1: \*P1, K1, repeat from \* to end

Row 2: \* P1, K1, repeat from \* to end

Work 7 more rows in 1x1 rib

Next row: rib 3, \* rib 2tog, rib 3, repeat from \* to end (23 stitches)

Change to 4mm needles

#### ***Lace pattern***

Row 1: knit

Row 2: purl

Row 3: K1, \*k1, yf, k2tog repeat from \* to last stitch, K1

Row 4: K1, \*k1, yf, k2tog, repeat from \* to last stitch, K1

Repeat rows 1-4 of lace pattern until work measures 15 cm ending with right side row

#### **Shape raglan**

Cast off 3 stitches, pattern to end of row (20 St)

Keeping lace pattern correct you will be decreasing 1 st at raglan edge of next and every alternate row as follows

**Row 1:** patt to last 3 st, k2tog, k1 (19sts)

**Row 2:** p2, patt to end

Repeat rows 1 & 2 until 11 sts remain on needle, ending with wrong side row.

#### ***Shape neck***

Cast off 3 sts, patt to last 3 sts, k2tog, k1. (7 st)

Row 1: patt

Row 2: k2tog, patt to last 3 st, k2tog, k1 (5 st)

Row 3: P2, patt to last 2 st, p2tog (4 sts)

Row 4: k1, k2tog. K1 (3 st)

Row 5: p3

Row 6: k2tog, k1 (2 st)

Row 7: p2tog

Fasten off

## Sleeves

Using 3.25mm needles cast on 33 stitches

### **1x1 Rib:**

Row 1: \*k1, p1, repeat to last stitch, k1

Row 2: \*p1, k1 repeat to last stitch, p1

Work 7 more rows in 1x1 rib

Next row: Rib 5, \*rib 2tog, rib 5, repeat from \* to end of row (29 stitches on needle)

Change to 4mm needles and work 4 rows of lace pattern

### **Lace pattern**

Row 1: knit

Row 2: purl

Row 3: K1, \*k1, yf, k2tog repeat from \* to last stitch, K1

Row 4: K1, \*k1, yf, k2tog, repeat from \* to last stitch, K1

Keeping continuity of pattern as set, increase 1 stitch at each end of next and every following 8<sup>th</sup> row until you have 35 stitches on needle.

Continue without shaping until sleeve measures 15cm.

### **Shape raglan**

Cast off 3 stitches a beginning of next 2 rows (29 st)

**Row 1:** k1, sl1, k1, pssso, pattern to last 3 stitches, k2tog, k1

**Row 2:** P2, pattern to last 2 stitches, P2

**Row 3:** k2, pattern to last 2 st, k2

**Row 4:** P2, pattern to last 2 st, P2

Repeat rows 1-4 twice more ( 12 rows worked, 23 stitches)

Repeat rows 1 & 2 until 9 stitches remain on needle ending with row 2. Cast off remaining 9 stitches.

## Neckband

Join raglan seams.

Using 3.25 mm needles

With right side facing pick up and knit 10 sts evenly along right side of neck, 9 sts from top of sleeve, 15 sts from back, 9 sts from top of sleeve, 10 sts from left side of neck ( 53 stitches)

**Next row:** knit

Starting with 2<sup>nd</sup> row of 1x1 rib, work 7 rows. Cast off in rib

## Left Front Border

With right side facing and Using 3.25mm needles pick up and knit

8 sts along neckband, 44sts along front edge and 9 sts along rib (61 sts)

Next row: knit

Starting with 1<sup>st</sup> row of 1x1 rib work 7 rows. Cast off in rib.

## Right Front Border

With right side facing and Using 3.25mm needles pick up and knit

9 sts along rib, 44 sts along front edge and 8 sts along neckband (61 sts)

Next row: knit

Starting with 1<sup>st</sup> row of 1x1 rib work 2 rows  
Buttonhole row: rib 3, yf k2tog, \* rib 13, yf, k2tog. Repeat from \* to last 6 sts. Rib 6 (5 buttonholes made)

Work 4 more rows in 1x1 rib. Cast off in rib.

### **To Make Up**

Join side and sleeve seams. Weave in ends. Sew on buttons. Pin out to the correct measurements and cover with a damp cloth and leave until dry.

### **Finished Measurements**

Chest: 48 cm ( 19 inches)

Length: 24 cm ( 9  $\frac{1}{2}$  inches)

Sleeve length: 15 cm ( 6 inches)
