

# Crochet Maddy Doll

**Approx. 10" tall with a head circumference of approx. 15"**

What you'll need:

- \*Size F hook
- \*I love this yarn or any WW in color of your choice
- \*Crochet needle for sewing in ends
- \*Stuffing

**Gauge: F hook, 10sc x 10rows = 2.5x2.5**

Abbreviations:

- \***ch**- chain
- \***sc**- single crochet
- \***scdec**- single crochet decrease

**Head:** With skin tone yarn and an F hook

**Round 1:** Mc, ch1, place 6sc inside the Mc, slst to join. (6) ***Now working in continuous rounds.***

**Round 2:** 2sc in each stitch around. (12)

**Round 3:** (2sc, sc) repeat around. (18)

**Round 4:** (2sc, sc next 2 stitches) repeat around. (24)

**Round 5:** (2sc, sc next 3 stitches) repeat around. (30)

**Round 6:** (2sc, sc next 4 stitches) repeat around. (36)

**Round 7:** (2sc, sc next 5 stitches) repeat around. (42)

**Round 8:** (2sc, sc next 6 stitches) repeat around (48)

**Round 9:** (2sc, sc next 7 stitches) repeat around (54)

**Round 10:** (2sc, sc next 8 stitches) repeat around. (60)

**Round 11-18:** sc in each stitch around. (60)

**Round 19:** (scdec, sc next 7 stitches) repeat around ending with sc in the last 4 stitches. (53)

**Round 20:** (scdec, sc next 6 stitches) repeat around ending with sc in last 3 stitches. (46)

**Round 21:** (scdec, sc next 5 stitches) repeat around ending with sc in last 2 stitches. (39)

**Round 22:** (scdec, sc next 4 stitches) repeat around ending with a sc in the last stitch. (32)

**Round 23:** (scdec, sc next 3 stitches) repeat around ending with a scdec in the last 2 stitches. (25)

**Round 24:** (scdec, sc next 2 stitches) repeat around ending with sc in the last 3 stitches. (19)



***\*Continue on to neck and body***

**Neck and Body:**

**Round 25-26:** sc in each stitch around.  
(19)

***\*Start of the shoulders***

**Round 27:** 2sc in each stitch around. (38)

**Round 28:** sc in each stitch around. (38)

**Round 29:** sc in next 9 stitches, ch6, skip 6 stitches, sc in the next stitch 12 stitches, ch6, skip 6 stitches, sc in next 5 stitches.  
(38 including chains)

**Round 30:** sc in each stitch around including the ch6 stitches. (38) (you've created the arm holes)

**Pace your safety eyes between rounds 15 and 16 about 10 stitches apart. Now stuff the head firmly.**

**Round 31-39:** sc in each stitch around.  
(38)

**Round 40:** sc in next 5 stitches, (\*place your stitch marker here for the new start of your round.) sc in next 17 stitches, reach across the crotch and slst back to the first stitch of your new round. (18) (see pink yarn stitch marker in pics) (white yarn is the old stitch marker, brown yarn is the crotch stitches you skip, pink yarn is the new stitch maker)



**Left Leg:** (You'll be continuing on to the Left Leg from the body. (Stuff the body as you go)

**Round 41-49:** sc in each stitch around. (18)

**Round 50:** sc in next 10 stitches, 2sc in each of the next 8 stitches. (26) (start of shoe)

**Round 51:** sc in next 12 stitches (\*2sc, sc) repeat\* 7 times. (33)

**Round 52:** sc in each stitch around. (33)

**Round 53:** sc in next 12 stitches, (\*scdec, sc) repeat 7 times. (26)

**Round 54:** sc in next 12 stitches, scdec 7 times. (19)

**Round 55:** scdec in each stitch around. (10)

**Round 56:** scdec in each stitch around. (5)

**\*finish stuffing the leg and the foot, tie off and leave a long tail, sew up the bottom of the foot.**



**Right Leg:** (you'll be looking at the back of your doll when you start)

**Round 40:** Leaving a long tail to sew up the crotch, reattach yarn one stitch away from the other leg. (see brown stitch marker for skipped stitch) Reach to the other side of the crotch, and sc one stitch away from other leg. Sc in the next 16 stitches. (18) (place stitch marker here)



***Continue working around***

**Round 41-49:** sc in each stitch around. (18) (at this point I removed my brown stitch marker and sewed up the crotch)

**Round 50:** sc in next 4 stitches, 2sc in each of the next 8 stitches, sc in last 6 stitches. (26) (start of foot)

**Round 51:** sc in next 4 stitches (\*2sc, sc) repeat\* 7 times, sc in last 8 stitches. (33)

**Round 52:** sc in each stitch around. (33)

**Round 53:** sc in next 6 stitches, (\*scdec, sc) repeat 7 times, sc in next 6 stitches. (26)

**Round 54:** sc in next 6 stitches, scdec 7 times, sc in last 6 stitches. (19)

**Round 55:** scdec in each stitch around, sc in last stitch. (10)



**Round 56:** scdec in each stitch around. (5)

**\*Finish stuffing the leg and the foot, tie off and leave a long tail, sew up the bottom of the foot**

**Arms (make 2):** (repeat for both sides)

**You'll be holding the doll upside down as you work**

**Round 1:** Reattach yarn to arm hole by placing a sc in the first stitch you skipped in round 34 and the next 5 stitches, continue to sc in each of the ch6 stitches you made in round 34, slst to join. (12) (the placement of the stitches doesn't really matter as long as you end with 12)

***\*Now working in continuous rounds. Stuff as you go.***

**Round 2-8:** sc in each stitch around. (12)

**Round 9:** 2sc in each stitch around. (24)

**Round 10-11:** sc in each stitch around. (24)

**Round 12:** scdec in each stitch around. (12)

***Round 13:*** scdec in each stitch around, sc in last stitch (6)



***\*Finish stuffing the arm, tie off and leave a long tail, sew up the bottom of the hand.***
