

Roses



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Material:

- Cottonyarn (red and green)
- Hook: 3 mm, US C/D
- Stuffing
- Needle (for sewing)
- Steel wire (1 for each rose)
- pipe cleaner (1 for each rose)

Abbreviations (US terms):

st – stitch

ch – chain

sc – single crochet

sl st – slip stitch

hdc – half double crochet

dc – double crochet

tr – triple crochet

dtr – double treble

picot – Ch 3, sl st in third ch from hook

Rnd – round

R – row

** - repeat from * to * around

(5) – The number is the total sc after end of round.

Finished size:

Length: 29 cm (11.4 inches)

Flower: 5 cm(2 inches) across and 4 cm (1.6 inches) high

Instructions:

Flower:

With red

Ch 80, start working in third ch from hook: hdc in every st, turn (78)

R2-R3 – Ch1, hdc in every st (78)

R4 – (Ch 2, 4 dc, Ch 2, sl st)*3 times, (Ch 2, 6 dc, Ch 2, sl st)*2 times, (Ch 3, 7 tr, Ch 3, sl st)*2 times, (Ch 4, 7 dtr, Ch 4, sl st)*3 times, Ch 4, 8 dtr, Ch 4, sl st

Start rolling the flower together with the beginning of R4 first, glue or sew while rolling to keep the flower to unroll.

Stem:

With green

6 sc in a magic circle (6)

Rnd2-Rnd52 – sc in every sc (6)

Rnd53 - *1 sc, 2 sc in next sc* (9)

Rnd54 – sc in every sc (9)

Rnd55 - *2 sc, 2 sc in next sc* (12)

Rnd56-Rnd57 – sc in every sc (12)

Rnd58 - *sl st, (Ch 4, sl st in second ch, sc in third ch, hdc in fourth ch) sl st* (5)

Rnd59 – sl st in every sc from rnd 57 (12)

Thread stem with pipe cleaner and steel wire, stuff bud lightly

Leaves (make 3):

With green

Ch 10, start working in second ch from hook

Rnd 1 – 3 sc, 4 hdc, sc, 3 sc in last ch, continue on opposite side, sc, 4 hdc, 3 sc

Rnd 2 – 2 sc in first sc, 2 sc, 4 hdc, 2 sc, (sc, picot, sc) in next sc, 2 sc, 4 hdc, 2 sc, 2 sc in next sc, join

Assembly:

Attach leaves on stem and then sew on flower
