

Crochet Hat Summer Breeze

Triple crochet (TR)

Double triple crochet (DTR)

The Size of the finished hat depends on the used material and your crocheting style as well. The pattern is available in one size only. The hat fits perfectly to head circumference of approximately 58/60cm (22.8/23.5”), but from my point of view (as it is a summer hat) it also looks great if worn slightly loose on a head with circumference of 56cm (22”).

Instruction

Hat

Row 1: make 10 DC into a magic ring, join with SlSt to the top of the first DC st. (10 sts)



Row 2: CH 2, 2 DC in the same st and in each st around, join with SlSt to the top of the first DC st. (20 sts)

Hook size: 3mm

Material:



You will need any **WORSTED** weight yarn in in one or a few colors for the hat, I've used:
✓ nature: 200g (Catania Grande)



For the flowers and the leaves I've used small amount of **SPORT** weight yarn in pink, light and dark green, yellow, light and dark violet colors.

- Needle and sewing thread

Abbreviations used:

Stitch/Stitches (st/sts)

Slip stitch (SlSt)

Chain (CH)

Single crochet (SC)

Double crochet (DC)

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Row 3: CH 2, 2 DC into the same st, *1 DC in the next st, 2 DC in each of the next 2 sts* - repeat it 6 times, 1 DC in the last st, join with SlSt to the top of the first DC st. (33 sts)



Row 4: CH 2, 1 DC into the same st, *2 DC in the next st, 1 DC in the next st* - repeat it 16 times, join with SlSt to the top of the first DC st. (49 sts)

Row 5: CH 2, 1 DC into the same st and in each st around, join with SlSt to the top of the first DC st. (49 sts)

Row 6: CH 2, 1 DC into the same st, 1 DC in the next st, *2 DC in the next st, 1 DC in each of the next 2 sts* - repeat it 15 times, 2 DC in next st, 1 DC in the last st, join with SlSt to the top of the first DC st. (65 sts)

Row 7: CH 2, 1 DC into the same st, 1 DC in the each of the next 11 sts, 2 DC in the next st, *1 DC in each of the next 12 sts, 2 DC in next st* - repeat it 4 times, join with SlSt to the top of the first DC st. (70 sts)

Row 8: CH 2, 1 DC into the same st, 1 DC in the each of the next 12 sts, 2 DC in the next st, *1 DC in each of the next 13 sts, 2 DC in next st* - repeat it 4 times, join with SlSt to the top of the first DC st. (75 sts)

Row 9: CH 2, 1 DC into the same st, 1 DC in the each of the next 13 sts, 2 DC in the next st, *1 DC in each of the next 14 sts, 2 DC in next st* - repeat it 4 times, join with SlSt to the top of the first DC st. (80 sts)

Row 10: CH 2, 1 DC into the same st, 1 DC in the each of the next 14 sts, 2 DC in the next st, *1 DC in each of the next 15 sts, 2 DC in next st* - repeat it 4 times, join with SlSt to the top of the first DC st. (85 sts)



Row 11: CH 2, 1 DC into the same st, 1 DC in the each of the next 15 sts, 2 DC in the next st, *1 DC in each of the next 16 sts, 2 DC in next st* - repeat it 4 times, join with SlSt to the top of the first DC st. (90 sts)

Row 12: CH 2, 1 DC into the same st, 1 DC in the each of the next 16 sts, 2 DC in the next st, *1 DC in each of the next 17 sts, 2 DC in next st* - repeat it 4 times, join with SlSt to the top of the first DC st. (95 sts)

Row 13: CH 2, 1 DC into the same st, 1 DC in the each of the next 17 sts, 2 DC in the next st, *1 DC in each of the next 18 sts, 2 DC in next st* - repeat it 4 times, join with SlSt to the top of the first DC st. (100 sts)

Row 14: CH 2, 1 DC into the same st, 1 DC in the each of the next 18 sts, 2 DC in the next st, *1 DC in each of the next 19 sts, 2 DC in next st* - repeat it 4 times, join with SlSt to the top of the first DC st. (105 sts)

Row 15-16: CH 2, 1 DC into the same st and in each st around, join with SlSt to the top of the first DC st. (105 sts)



Row 17: CH 2, 1 DC into the same st, 1 DC in the each of the next 13 sts, 2 DC in the next st, *1 DC in each of the next 14 sts, 2 DC in next st* - repeat it 6 times, join with SlSt to the top of the first DC st. (112 sts)

Row 18: CH 2, 1 DC into the same st, 1 DC in the each of the next 12 sts, 2 DC in the next st, *1 DC in each of the next 13 sts, 2 DC in next st* - repeat it 7 times, join with SlSt to the top of the first DC st. (120 sts)

Row 19: CH 2, 1 DC into the same st, 1 DC in the each of the next 13 sts, 2 DC in the next st, *1 DC in each of the next 14 sts, 2 DC in next st* - repeat it 7 times, join with SlSt to the top of the first DC st. (128 sts)

Row 20: CH 2, 1 DC into the same st, 1 DC in the each of the next 14 sts, 2 DC in the next st, *1 DC in each of the next 15 sts, 2 DC in next st* - repeat it 7 times, join with SlSt to the top of the first DC st. (136 sts)

Row 21: CH 2, 1 DC into the same st, 1 DC in the each of the next 15 sts, 2 DC in the next st, *1 DC in each of the next 16 sts, 2 DC in next st* - repeat it 7 times, join with SlSt to the top of the first DC st. (144 sts)

Row 22: CH 2, 1 DC into the same st, 1 DC in the each of the next 16 sts, 2 DC in the next st, *1 DC in each of the next 17 sts, 2 DC in next st* - repeat it 7 times, join with SlSt to the top of the first DC st. (152 sts)

Row 23: CH 2, 1 DC into the same st, 1 DC in the each of the next 17 sts, 2 DC in the next st, *1 DC in each of the next 18 sts, 2 DC in next st* - repeat it 7 times, join with SlSt to the top of the first DC st. (160 sts)

Row 24: CH 2, 1 DC into the same st, 1 DC in the each of the next 18 sts, 2 DC in the next st, *1 DC in each of the next 19 sts, 2 DC in next st* - repeat it 7 times, join with SlSt to the top of the first DC st. (168 sts)

Row 25: CH 2, 1 DC into the same st and in each st around. (168 sts)

Fasten off and secure the ends.

Tie

With light green color: make CH sts until the tie measures ~200cm (~78.5"). Cut off the yarn and secure the ends.

Flowers – make 3

Note: For each flower I've use different colors for the stamens and the petals.

Stamen: make 5 SC into a magic ring. Fasten off and secure the ends.

Petals: join contrasting color at any st from the stamen. In every SC st make: *CH 4, 3 DTR, 1 DC, SlSt to the next SC of the working round* - repeat it though the entire round (5 times in total).

Fasten off and secure the ends.

Leaf – make 2

Note: Use dark green color yarn.

CH 8, make 1 DC into the second st from the hook, 1 DC in each of the next 2 sts, 1 TR in each of the next 3 sts, 1 DC in each of the next 2 sts, CH 1 and continue working on the other side of the chain row as follows: make 1 DC in the first st, 1 DC in the next st, 1 TR in each of the next 3 sts, 1 DC in each of the next 2 sts, join with SlSt to the top of the first DC st.

Fasten off and secure the ends.



Finishing

Note: *If you would like your hat much more colorful, you can make bigger flowers and leaves (by using thicker yarn or hook) or just increase their number. I just wanted my hat as simple as possible and that's why I decided to use only 3 flowers.*

Place the tie two times around the hat. Make a knot.



Fix the tie by sewing it gently on one side of the knot, leave the other part free, so that you can adjust the size of the tie if needed.
