



THE FALL SHAWL

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MATERIALS

J hook (6 mm)
DK Weight Yarn
4 Stitch Markers
Yarn Needle
Scissors

GAUGE

11 dc and 9 rows = 4" square

YARN NOTES

I used 4 hanks of Bad Sheep DK yarn.
You'll need 2 hanks MC and 2 hanks CC

Each hank of the DK is:
3.5 oz. / 240 yds.

COLORWAY

MC – Golden Heart
CC – Blackberry

YARDAGE

MC – 480 yds. CC – 250 yds. (730 yds. total)

PATTERN NOTES

You will not count your turning ch as a st.

My shawl, finished and blocked, measures 19" wide and 80" long.

Row 3 and on: Use your 4 stitch markers to mark each decrease within the body of your shawl (not the outer edge decreases). This will make crocheting your shawl much easier.

SPECIAL STITCHES

Dc2togcl – Double crochet two together cluster – yo, insert hk into indicated st, yo and pull up a lp, yo and pull through two, yo and insert hk into next st, yo and pull up a lp, yo and pull through two, yo and insert hk into same st, yo and pull up a lp, yo and pull through two, yo and pull through last 4 lps on hk.

Tr3togsk2 – treble crochet 3 together skip 2 – yo twice, insert hk into indicated st, yo and pull up a lp, yo and pull through two, yo and pull through two, (skip next, yo twice, insert hk into next st, yo and pull up a lp, yo and pull through two, yo and pull through two) twice, yo and pull through last 4 lps on hk.



ABBREVIATIONS

Hk – hook

Yo – yarn over

Lp(s) – loop(s)

Flo – front loop only

Ch – chain

Hdc – half double crochet

Dc – double crochet

St(s) – stitch(es)

Slst – slip stitch

Sc – single crochet

Dc2tog – dc two together

Dc2togcl – see Special Stitches

Tr3togsk2 – see Special Stitches

SHAWL

With MC, Ch 458

Row 1 – slst in 2nd ch from hk, slst in next 5, *skip 2, slst in next 11, repeat from * up to last 9, skip 2, slst in last 7. (387 slst and 35 picots)

Note: *Remember, you will not be counting your beg ch as a st.*

Row 2 – Ch 1 and turn, working in flo, sc in first 2, *hdc in next, dc in next, tr3togsk2, dc in next, hdc in next, sc in next 2, repeat from * across. (247)

Row 3 – Ch 2 and turn, *dc2tog, dc in next 47, repeat from * up to last 2, work dc2togcl. (241)

Row 4 – Ch 2 and turn, dc2tog, dc in next 46, skip next, *dc in next 47, skip next, repeat from * up to last 48, dc in next 46, dc2togcl. (235)

Row 5 – Ch 2 and turn, dc2tog, dc in next 44, dc2tog, *dc in next 45, dc2tog, repeat from * up to last 46, dc in next 44, dc2togcl. (229)

Row 6 – Ch 2 and turn, dc2tog, dc in next 43, skip next, *dc in next 45, skip next, repeat from * up to last 45, dc in next 43, dc2togcl. (223)

Row 7 – Ch 2 and turn, dc2tog, dc in next 41, dc2tog, *dc in next 43, dc2tog, repeat from * up to last 43, dc in next 41, dc2togcl. (217)

Row 8 – Ch 2 and turn, dc2tog, dc in next 40, skip next, *dc in next 43, skip next, repeat from * up to last 42, dc in next 40, dc2togcl. (211)

Row 9 – Ch 2 and turn, dc2tog, dc in next 38, dc2tog, *dc in next 41, dc2tog, repeat from * up to last 40, dc in next 38, dc2togcl. (205)

Row 10 – Ch 2 and turn, dc2tog, dc in next 37, skip next, *dc in next 41, skip next, repeat from * up to last 39, dc in next 37, dc2togcl. (199)

Row 11 – Ch 2 and turn, dc2tog, dc in next 35, dc2tog, *dc in next 39, dc2tog, repeat from * up to last 37, dc in next 35, dc2togcl. (193)

Row 12 – Ch 2 and turn, dc2tog, dc in next 34, skip next, *dc in next 39, skip next, repeat from * up to last 36, dc in next 34, dc2togcl. (187)

Row 13 – Ch 2 and turn, dc2tog, dc in next 32, dc2tog, *dc in next 37, dc2tog, repeat from * up to last 34, dc in next 32, dc2togcl. (181)

Row 14 – Ch 2 and turn, dc2tog, dc in next 31, skip next, *dc in next 37, skip next, repeat from * up to last 33, dc in next 31, dc2togcl. (175)

Row 15 – Ch 2 and turn, dc2tog, dc in next 29, dc2tog, *dc in next 35, dc2tog, repeat from * up to last 31, dc in next 29, dc2togcl. (169)

Row 16 – Ch 2 and turn, dc2tog, dc in next 28, skip next, *dc in next 35, skip next, repeat from * up to last 30, dc in next 28, dc2togcl. (163)

Row 17 – Ch 2 and turn, dc2tog, dc in next 26, dc2tog, *dc in next 33, dc2tog, repeat from * up to last 28, dc in next 26, dc2togcl. (157)

Change to CC

Row 18 – Ch 2 and turn, dc2tog, dc in next 25, skip next, *dc in next 33, skip next, repeat from * up to last 27, dc in next 25, dc2togcl. (151)

Row 19 – Ch 2 and turn, dc2tog, dc in next 23, dc2tog, *dc in next 31, dc2tog, repeat from * up to last 25, dc in next 23, dc2togcl. (145)

Row 20 – Ch 2 and turn, dc2tog, dc in next 22, skip next, *dc in next 31, skip next, repeat from * up to last 24, dc in next 22, dc2togcl. (139)

Row 21 – Ch 2 and turn, dc2tog, dc in next 20, dc2tog, *dc in next 29, dc2tog, repeat from * up to last 22, dc in next 20, dc2togcl. (133)

Row 22 – Ch 2 and turn, dc2tog, dc in next 19, skip next, *dc in next 29, skip next, repeat from * up to last 21, dc in next 19, dc2togcl. (127)

Row 23 – Ch 2 and turn, dc2tog, dc in next 17, dc2tog, *dc in next 27, dc2tog, repeat from * up to last 19, dc in next 17, dc2togcl. (121)

Row 24 – Ch 2 and turn, dc2tog, dc in next 16, skip next, *dc in next 27, skip next, repeat from * up to last 18, dc in next 16, dc2togcl. (115)

Row 25 – Ch 2 and turn, dc2tog, dc in next 14, dc2tog, *dc in next 25, dc2tog, repeat from * up to last 16, dc in next 14, dc2togcl. (109)

Row 26 – Ch 2 and turn, dc2tog, dc in next 13, skip next, *dc in next 25, skip next, repeat from * up to last 15, dc in next 13, dc2togcl. (103)

Row 27 – Ch 2 and turn, dc2tog, dc in next 11, dc2tog, *dc in next 23, dc2tog, repeat from * up to last 13, dc in next 11, dc2togcl. (97)

Row 28 – Ch 2 and turn, dc2tog, dc in next 10, skip next, *dc in next 23, skip next, repeat from * up to last 12, dc in next 10, dc2togcl. (91)

Row 29 – Ch 2 and turn, dc2tog, dc in next 8, dc2tog, *dc in next 21, dc2tog, repeat from * up to last 10, dc in next 8, dc2togcl. (85)

Row 30 – Ch 2 and turn, dc2tog, dc in next 7, skip next, *dc in next 21, skip next, repeat from * up to last 9, dc in next 7, dc2togcl. (79)

Row 31 – Ch 2 and turn, dc2tog, dc in next 5, dc2tog, *dc in next 19, dc2tog, repeat from * up to last 7, dc in next 5, dc2togcl. (73)

Row 32 – Ch 2 and turn, dc2tog, dc in next 4, skip next, *dc in next 19, skip next, repeat from * up to last 6, dc in next 4, dc2togcl. (67)

Row 33 – Ch 2 and turn, dc2tog, dc in next 2, dc2tog, *dc in next 17, dc2tog, repeat from * up to last 4, dc in next 2, dc2togcl. (61)

Row 34 – Ch 2 and turn, dc2tog, dc in next, skip next, *dc in next 17, skip next, repeat from * up to last 3, dc in next, dc2togcl. (55)

Row 35 – Ch 2 and turn, (dc2tog) twice, dc in next 14, dc2tog, dc in next 15, dc2tog, dc in next 14, (dc2tog) twice. (49)

Row 36 – Ch 2 and turn, (dc2tog) twice, dc in next 12, dc2tog, dc in next 13, dc2tog, dc in next 12, (dc2tog) twice. (43)

Row 37 – Ch 2 and turn, (dc2tog) twice, dc in next 10, dc2tog, dc in next 11, dc2tog, dc in next 10, (dc2tog) twice. (37)

Row 38 – Ch 2 and turn, (dc2tog) twice, dc in next 8, dc2tog, dc in next 9, dc2tog, dc in next 8, (dc2tog) twice. (31)

Row 39 – Ch 2 and turn, (dc2tog) twice, dc in next 6, dc2tog, dc in next 7, dc2tog, dc in next 6, (dc2tog) twice. (25)

Row 40 – Ch 1 and turn, slst in first 2, sc in next 2, hdc in next 2, dc in next 13, hdc in next 2, sc in next 2, slst in last 2. (25)

Fasten off and weave in all ends.

Block it

- 1) Run your shawl under cold water, being sure not to rub it together too much.
- 2) Squeeze as much water as you can out of your shawl.
- 3) Lay your shawl out on a flat surface, making sure everything is straight and lined up in the shape that you want the shawl to be. Let it sit, undisturbed, to dry.
- 4) Once dry, you can wear and enjoy!
