

# The Pale Lady

## Technical information

- Yarn: Approx. 440 yd / 400 m fingering weight yarn
- Needles: US 4 / 3,5 mm needles
- Gauge: 28 sts = 10 cm / 4 in in st st. Gauge is not crucial.

## Pattern

### Cast on

Cast on 218 sts.

3 sts on both ends of the needles form the garter stitch edges. These stitches are not charted, always knit these stitches.

### Work charts

Work Chart A across all stitches between garter stitch borders. White background denotes repeat section, purple stitches are worked only once per row - same applies to Chart B.

### Note on Chart A & B WS rows

On WS, knit the garter stitch edge stitches, purl all purls and yarn overs, knit all knits, *with the following exceptions:*

- RS ktbl  : on WS, purl through back of the loop
- RS drop stitch + yarn over  : on WS, purl the yarn over through back of the loop, ignore dropped stitch
- RS double yo  : on WS, knit first yo, purl second yo. The order of knit and purl makes a small difference in the visual formation of the stitch, knit first then purl is recommended.

After Chart A has been worked vertically for a total of five times, begin Chart B.

Work through Chart B once, end with WS row. 179 sts remain.

### Short row shaping

With RS facing, k until 7 sts remain, ssk, k1, turn.

With WS facing, p until 7 sts remain, p2tog, p1, turn.

**Repeat row 1:** k until 7 sts before gap, ssk, k1, turn.

**Repeat row 2:** p until 7 sts before gap, p2tog, p1, turn.

Repeat previous two rows until 14 sts (or less) remain between gaps formed by turns. With WS facing, p until 7 sts remain before gap, p2tog, p across the previous turn points until 3 sts remain on left needle (garter stitch tab stitches), k3 sts.

### Binding off with I-cord bind-off

With RS facing, cast on 3 sts to left needle.

\*Knit 2 sts, ssk. Slip 3 sts back to left needle.\*  
Repeat \*\* until only 3 sts remain.

Sl 3 sts to left needle, k 3 sts.

Sl 3 sts to left needle, k3tog.

Cut yarn, pull through loop.

### Finishing

Unravel all dropped stitches all the way down to (and through) cast-on edge. Block shawl to shape, weave in all yarn ends.


#### Selling items made with this pattern:

Symbol	Explanation

	Yarn over, drop next stitch off left needle. On next row, purl yarn over through back loop
	Sl 1 to cable needle (cn), hold front, k1, k1 from cn
	Sl 1 to cn, hold back, k1, k1 from cn
	Sl 1 to cn, hold front, p1, k1 from cn
	Sl 1 to cn, hold back, k1, p1 from cn
	Sl 2 to cn, hold front, k1, k2 from cn
	Sl 1 to cn, hold back, k2, k1 from cn
	Sl 2 to cn, hold front, p1, k2 from cn
	Sl 1 to cn, hold back, k2, p1 from cn
	Sl 2 to cn, hold front, k2, k2 from cn
	No stitch (ignore in chart)
